## Important Highlights

### 9. International

- a. Taking advantage of **world's preoccupation with the pandemic, BJP government has amended domicile rules of Indian Held Kashmir** in a bid to change the disputed region's demography.
- b. **IMF approved 1.4 billion dollars to Pakistan** to stabilize economy amid COVID-19 crisis.
- c. **ADB has repurposed USD 50 million** from National Disaster Risk Management Fund (NDRMF) to **support government's preventive and response efforts** to fight COVID-19.
- d. America National Library of Medicine has approved **20 members team of Ayub Medical College to find a cure for coronavirus.**
- e. **China reiterated its willingness to continue supporting Pakistan** in the fight against COVID pandemic.
- f. Scientists warned that **lockdown measures in China must be lifted gradually** in order **to prevent a 'second wave'** of COVID-19.

### 10. National

- a. DRAP granted approval for **a passive immunization technique, local production of ventilators and manufacturing of pharma ingredients for chloroquine.**
- b. As per Pakistan Counsel in Dubai, about **10,000 Pakistani's have lost their jobs in UAE while 35,000 have applied to return to Pakistan.**
- c. **17,000 Ehsas Kafalat Center opened** / started operations to give Rs 12000 each to needy 1 crore 20 lac families.
- d. **Number of beds** for COVID patients at Rawalpindi Institute of Urology (RIU) being **increased from 180 to 300** in next two weeks.
- e. Fly Dubai **plans to resume flights to Pakistan and India from 16 April 2020**, reserved solely for Pakistani and Indian nationals.
- f. Sindh Chief Minister called for **devising an effective strategy and post-lockdown guidelines** to deal with the crisis.
- g. Foreign Minister said that **Pakistan looks forward to learn from Singapore's experience** in the **field of epidemiology** since it took **deft measures** to contain the spread of coronavirus.
- h. PM commented that **decision about easing the countrywide lockdown** will be taken **after receiving inputs from all the provinces** by 14 Apr 20.
