## Important Highlights

### 9. International

- a. **As per WHO seventy vaccines for COVID are under development** around the world with **three being already tested in human trials**.
- b. **Italy has reported its lowest COVID death toll** which is 431 deaths in more than three weeks, confirming reaching peak of the epi curve.
- c. **Sri Lanka made cremations compulsory** for COVID victims irrespective of their religion; Muslims protested on this decision.
- d. **Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi extended a nationwide lockdown till 3 May 2020** as number of COVID cases are on rise despite a three-week shutdown.

### 10. National

- a. Ministry of Interior announces **extension in borders closure for two more weeks** to include Kartapur corridor, Western and Wagha borders.
- b. Many devotees visited at Sehwan Sharif for urs of Lal Shahbaz Qalandar, however, were **denied to perform rituals by management**.
- c. **KP government decided to reopen 80 % of industries and 28 hospitals** after prolonged closure amid COVID pandemic.
- d. At least **89 prisoners tested positive** for COVID in various prisons in Punjab so far, meriting attention of concerned quarters.
- e. **Protests** were carried out in some villages of District Badin, Shikarpur, Sukkur, Ghotki, Jacobabad and Khairpur **due to non-provision of rations**.
