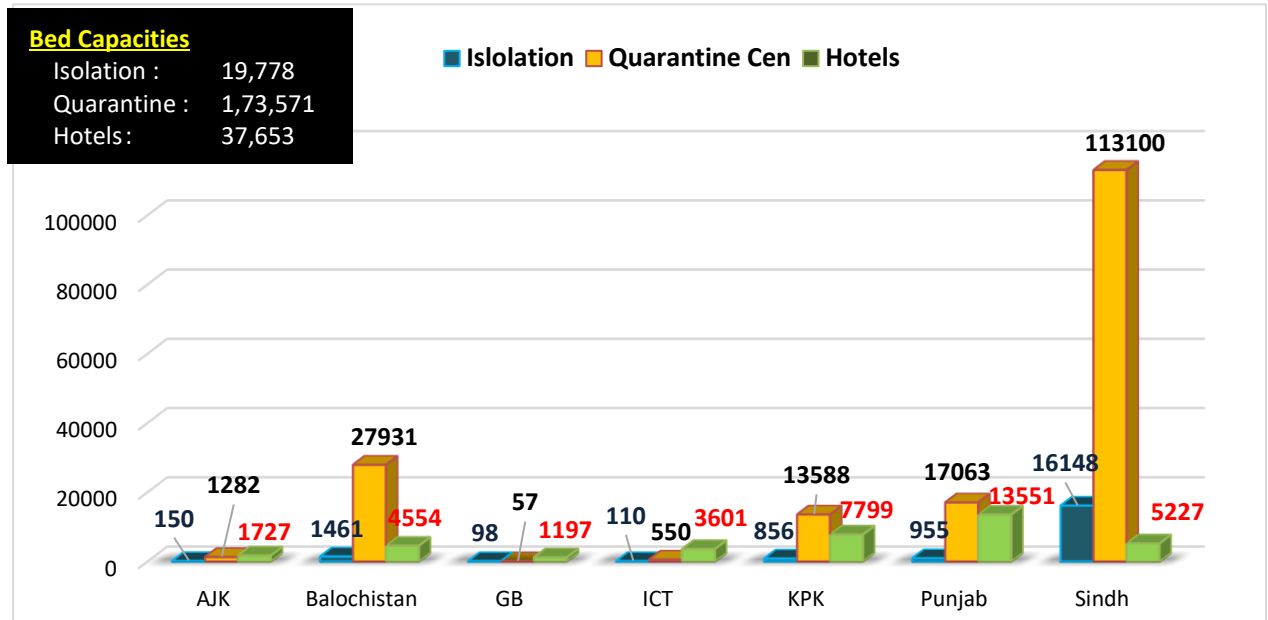

## 7. Important Highlights

- UN conference on Trade and Development has bracketed Pakistan among the countries which would be hardest hit by COVID-19. **Concerned ministries to further analyse the issues for risk mitigation.**
- A Chinese medical expert team including 8 x doctors and medical officials are visiting Islamabad, Lahore and Karachi from 28 Mar – 10 Apr. **Visit of KP and Balochistan Province may also be planned by Ministry of NHR&C.**
- Government of Sindh, on request of MoMA, has declared port operations, customs and Pakistan National Shipping Cooperation as essential services, **likely to generate limited economic activity.**
- Pakistan Ulema Council issued a Fatwa against hoarding of basic food items and profiteering. **Its effects on hoardings and profiteers be monitored by respective Ministries / Provinces.**
