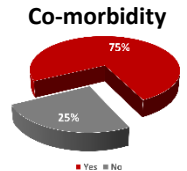
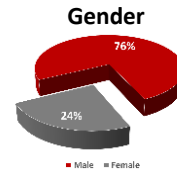
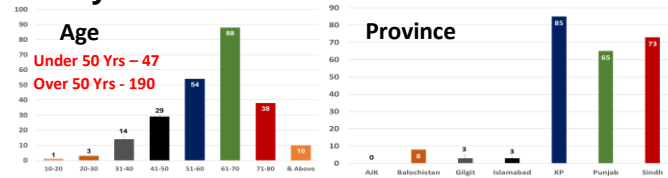
5. Clinical Status of COVID Cases



6. Category of COVID Spread

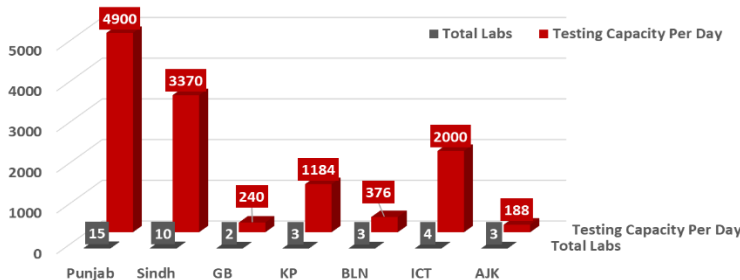


7. Analysis of Death Cases – 237 Deaths

Important Highlights

9. International

- a. **Pakistan received an emergency loan of \$1.39 billion from IMF** to cope with the COVID pandemic.
- b. **The Islamic Development Bank has approved \$2.3 billion 'Strategic Preparedness and Response Package'** for member countries to mitigate and recover from the impact of COVID.
- c. **Pakistan hosted a virtual conference** of ministers and senior officials from **SAARC** to discuss a common strategy to deal with COVID.
- d. **PM and US President held a telephonic conversation** to discuss COVID pandemic. US President publicly promised to provide ventilators to Pakistan.
- e. **WHO warned that the COVID crisis will not end any time soon**; with many countries only in the early stages of the fight.
- f. **Germany has authorized its first clinical test of a vaccine** for COVID on human volunteers developed by German firm Biontech and US Giant Pfizer.
- g. Spain will **ease lockdown** in the second half of May 2020.
- h. **591 American and British citizens stranded** in Pakistan have been **repatriated** to their home countries on chartered flights.
- i. Indian Council of Medical Research has asked states to **pause use of Chinese testing kits over concerns of being faulty**.

10. National

- a. **SAPM on Health cautioned that the next 3-4 weeks are critical** for Pakistan in terms of COVID infections and deaths.
- b. **PM launched Ehsaas Emergency Cash Information Portal** to make public details of disbursements and to add transparency to system.
- c. President said the **agreement with the religious scholars was Ijma-e-Ummat** and its violation would be categorized as a sin.
- d. **PM conducted a telethon** to raise funds for National fight against COVID.
- e. **Sardar Mustafa Khan Tareen** (former minister Balochistan government) **passed away** after being infected by the COVID.
- f. News related to NCOC: -
 - (1) **COAS visited NCOC** and lauded its response to the COVID threat in the Country.
 - (2) NCOC announced that it has finalized **arrangements for the screening, testing and tracking for the controlled return of Pakistanis** stranded in Afghanistan through the **Chaman & Tourkham border**.
 - (3) NCOC stated that the **Pakistan Railways has sent quarantine train consisting of 30 passenger coaches along with medical supplies and two medical coaches to Balochistan**. 400 patients can be isolated and housed in the makeshift quarantine centres.
