9. **International**

- a. World Bank cautioned that **Pakistan's economy can shrink by 1.3% to 2.2%** in the current fiscal year whereas **IMF says the economy could contract by 1.5%**.
- b. **UK PM returned to 10 Downing Street** after spending a week in the hospital with COVID and two weeks recovering at his country residence.
- c. **Iran plans to reopen Mosques** in parts of the country that have been free from COVID outbreak.
- d. **Chile to introduce 'virus-free' certification** for the people recovered from virus infection.
- e. **Australia launches COVID tracking app** to trace people potentially exposed to infection.
- f. **UN** asked international organizations, world leaders and private sector to **join hands for developing a vaccine**.
- g. US Congressman stated that **draconian restrictions placed in Kashmir by India must be lifted** so that people can take preventive measures against COVID.
- h. Canada cautioned against the use of malaria drugs **hydroxy chloroquine and chloroquine, as it can cause serious heart rhythm problems**.
- i. The global death toll from **COVID surpassed 200,000** on Saturday, with more than **50,000 of those deaths in the US**. Meanwhile, **Centre for Disease Control added six new symptoms** to its list of possible signs of the COVID.
- j. Socio economic boycott of Muslims in India specially in Ahmedabad and Telangana amid COVID pandemic is in full swing. **Plight of Muslims in India amid COVID environment must be exposed at international forums**.

10. **National**

- a. A survey has shown that **more than 80 % of Mosques in Punjab and the federal capital did not implement the agreement** reached between the government and Ulema on the first Taraveeh congregation on Friday.
- b. Drug Regulatory Authority of Pakistan (DRAP) has issued a **ten points advisory for pharmacists** to protect them from COVID.

- c. **PIA will operate 103 flights to repatriate approximately 20,000 stranded Pakistanis** from UK, UAE, France, Germany, Bahrain, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Muscat, Malaysia and Oslo by 9th May 2020.
- d. **Pakistani Peacekeepers rescued more than 2000 people** stranded due to heavy floods in Uvira region in Democratic Republic of CONGO.
- e. Authorities in **Punjab have registered 2,105 first information report (FIR) against lockdown violations.**
- f. **AJK government decided to increase restrictions at the entry points;** government decided that those coming to the region will not be allowed to exit till Eid.
- g. Islamabad administration formulated **15 teams to keep a check on the prices in the federal capital.**
- h. **NCOC allowed use of jetties for the fishermen community.** Ministry of Maritime Affair will coordinate with provincial government for refinement & enforcement of SOPs.
- i. **Sindh government expanded the field hospital** set up at Karachi's Expo Centre by 300 beds.
- j. **Doctors in Quetta call for 20 days curfew** to curb COVID spread.
- k. **Sindh Govt notified SOPs for online businesses** / e-commerce during pandemic.
