Important Highlights

- Germany leads Europe with its large-scale testing (more than 50,000 per day) and lower fatality rate than its neighbouring countries. **Best global practices may be analyzed for adoption.**
- Government announced Rs 100 billion package for construction industry to maintain economic stability and create job opportunity. **This measure will facilitate in generating economic activity and will provide relief to industry as well as daily wagers under COVID environment.**

9. Ministry of Planning, Development, Reforms and Special Initiatives has estimated that 12.3 to 18.5 million people in country may lose their jobs and economy may face Rs 2 to 2.5 trillion losses in three months **thereby meriting fore-planning for risk mitigation by all stakeholders.**
10. PIA flight from Toronto via Istanbul carrying 195 passengers and 18 x crew members (total: 213) from Turkey landed at Islamabad International Airport at 6:00 PM on 3 April 2020. **Arrangements for testing, accommodation and their transportation etc by respective agencies were made as per policy.**
11. As an outcome of session held at NCOC on 2 April 2020, a special flight of C-130 operated on 3 April 2020 from Dalbandin to Skardu for move of 25 x Zaireen hailing from GB. **3 x Zaireen were declared positive and shifted to isolation facility at Quetta.**
12. Pakistan Standards and Quality Control Authority (PSQCA) conducted sample testing of sanitizers available in market and banned 23 x brands which were not in conformity with WHO standards. **Relevant ministries may take necessary measures at Federal / Provincial levels for removal of these brands from market.**
13. **Capacity Enhancement of Medical Facilities**
- a. World Bank donated 40 ventilators to KP Government **which will contribute in capacity building of the province.**
 - b. **1200 x Beds isolation facility established at Expo Centre Karachi** on 2 April 2020 for confirmed COVID-19 patients.
 - c. **150 x bedded isolation center** established at **Agriculture College, Quetta.**
 - d. 5 x pre-fabricated containers out of total 16 arrived at Taftan from Quetta through NDMA. 160 x Pre-fabricated containers will be assembled locally at Taftan to establish quarantine facility.
