Clinical Status of COVID

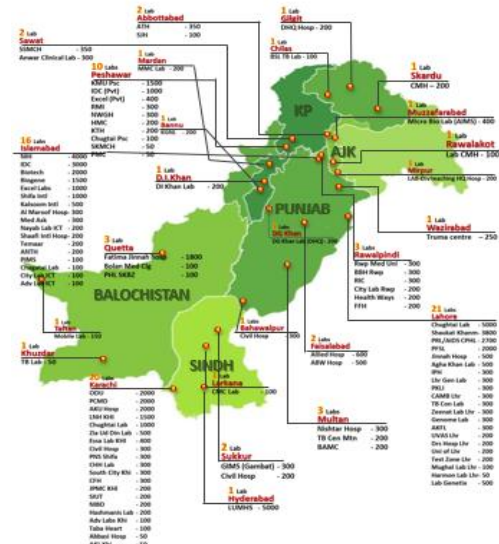
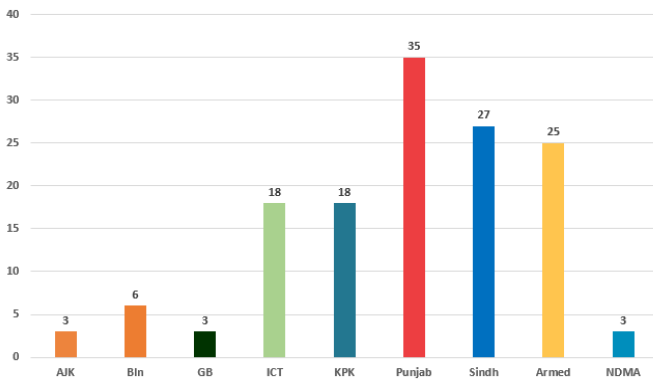


Death Analysis

1. **International**

- a. **Greece reported 203 new cases of COVID**, highest daily tally since start of outbreak in the country.
- b. Britain's Education Secretary has said that **there is little evidence of COVID transmission in schools**.
- c. **Bill gates has appreciated Pakistan effort in containing COVID**.
- d. US President Donald Trump still wants to see **coronavirus aid legislation pass that would include stimulus payments to individuals and school funding**.
- e. The US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) reported **5,023,649 cases of the coronavirus, an increase of 48,690 cases from its previous count**.
- f. Global COVID cases have crossed **20 million with the United States, Brazil and India accounting for more than half of all known infections**.
- g. Finland will introduce **mandatory coronavirus tests and quarantines for travelers arriving from designated high-risk countries**.

2. **National**

- a. Pakistan Overseas Employment Promoters Association (POEPA) has said that **over 200,000 expatriates could not go abroad due to the COVID pandemic**.
- b. **Punjab government on Monday announced to lift all restrictions** ending the smart lockdown across the province.
- c. Federal Minister for Planning and Development Asad Umar has said that **federal government's policy of smart lockdown against COVID was a success**.
- d. **Moody's has reaffirmed Pakistan B3 credit rating** with a stable outlook.
- e. Sindh Information Minister Nasir Hussain Shah has cautioned that **schools and wedding hall owners against reopening before September 15**, saying that masses should continue to exercise caution even after the COVID lockdown is lifted.
