## 1. International

- a. **Dutch government plans to order mandatory quarantine** for people who are known to have been exposed to COVID.
- b. As per U.S. Energy Information Administration (EIA), **US electricity consumption will drop 3.4% in 2020** as coronavirus lockdowns caused businesses to close.
- c. US health researchers have found in a study of a Maryland facility that **Nursing home residents on kidney dialysis had roughly three times the rate of COVID** compared to those not receiving treatment.
- d. **Facebook has said that it has removed 7 million posts** in the second quarter for sharing false information about the novel coronavirus.
- e. **Swiss government has decided to reserve doses of an early-stage drug** that the Zurich-area biotechnology company is developing for COVID.
- f. Global COVID tally has crossed 20 Mn.
- g. Brazil's Paraná state is in **talks with Russia to produce a COVID vaccine**.
- h. France has extended a ban on public gatherings of more than 5,000 people to 30 October as coronavirus infections rise sharply
- i. **Number of new coronavirus cases among children in US rose 40%** in the last two weeks of July.
- j. World Health Organization has **urged governments and citizens to work to suppress the COVID**.

## 2. National

- a. **Asad umar urges people to participate in the 'wear a mask challenge'**.
- b. National Tourism Coordination Board Chairman Zulfikar Bukhari has said that **reopening of tourism sector in the country is due to the government's effective policies against the virus**.
- c. Federal Minister for Planning and Development Asad Umar said the threat of the virus still remains and if **SOPs are not followed, the virus will continue to spread**.
- d. Prime Minister Imran Khan told Maldivian President Ibrahim Solih that **major sectors of Pakistan's economy are gradually reopening**.
- e. Business community and traders have **hailed the government's smart lockdown strategy, adopted to combat COVID**, saying that it benefited local businesses, particularly the export and construction sectors.
