## 1. International

- a. WHO chief has said that **world needs to spend at least \$100 billion on new tools to combat COVID pandemic.**
- b. Novavax US drug manufacture has said **that South Korea's SK bioscience would manufacture a component of its experimental COVID vaccine** in a bid to boost its supply.
- c. **Indonesia's capital Jakarta has extended its social restrictions** to stem surging COVID transmission.
- d. **Israel's largest medical center has developed a saliva test** that is able to determine in less than a second whether a person is infected with COVID.
- e. **Regional body in Africa has said that Seven African countries** will start administering COVID antibody tests from next week.
- f. **US has reported that number of citizens seeking jobless benefits have dropped below one Mn last week** for the first time since the start of the COVID pandemic.
- g. **England has launched a new version of its delayed COVID smartphone app** using Google and Apple contact tracing technology.
- h. **Finland recommended the use of face masks in public** for the first time as the number of coronavirus cases rises.
- i. **India has reported record daily rise in COVID cases (67,000)** , while the death toll from COVID surpassed 47,000.

## 2. National

- a. Peshawar Zoo authorities have said that they will **reopen the zoo for general public from August 18.**
- b. Punjab disaster management authority has cautioned **people that the "threat of COVID-19 is not over yet".**
- c. **Rs 540 billion of PM Imran Khan's COVID economic relief package** that had to be distributed through ministries, could not reach people during peak crisis times.
- d. **FM honours 86 overseas Pakistanis** for COVID services.
