




Cases Vs Recovery



Clinical Status of COVID





Death Analysis

1. International

- a. Germany's vaccines regulator said **some groups of people living in the country could be vaccinated as early as next year against COVID.**
- b. **South Korea has warned of a nationwide wave of infections**, after Korea Centres for Disease Control and Prevention (KCDC) reported its highest daily rise in COVID cases since early March.
- c. LATAM Airlines, a South American carrier said that **12,600 employees have been laid off since March almost, 30% of its workforce.**
- d. **New Zealand said it would increase the number of defence personnel at its quarantine facilities and border** to contain any further spread of the coronavirus.
- e. Hong Kong's banking regulator has said that it would relax commercial property mortgage rules, to boost liquidity in a market that has **suffered due to US-China trade tensions, violent street protests and COVID crisis.**
- f. **Czech Republic health Minister has said that not take part in WHO-led COVAX plan** to develop and distribute a vaccine against COVID, instead will opt for an EU initiative.
- g. Pope Francis has said that **Rich countries should not hoard COVID vaccine** and should only give pandemic-related bailouts to companies committed to protecting the environment.

2. National

- a. **Sindh Health Minister Dr Azra Pechuho opposed the decision to reopen primary schools** amid the pandemic.
- b. Balochistan Governor Amanullah Khan Yasinzai said **all available resources are being utilised for economic stability in the province amid the pandemic.**
- c. Balochistan government spokesman on has said that **tally of coronavirus cases seemed to be increasing in the province.**
- d. Punjab Minister for Education has said that **final decision for reopening educational institutions will be made at a meeting in the first week of September.**
- e. Adviser to CM Punjab on Health has said that **SOPs should be strictly observed during processions in Muharram.**
- f. Sindh Institute of Urology and Transplantation (SIUT) has **announced its decision to resume transplantation activities soon**, after they remained suspended due to the coronavirus pandemic for month.

- g. Prime Minister Imran Khan has said the **smart lockdown proved to be very effective in containing the spread of the virus.**
