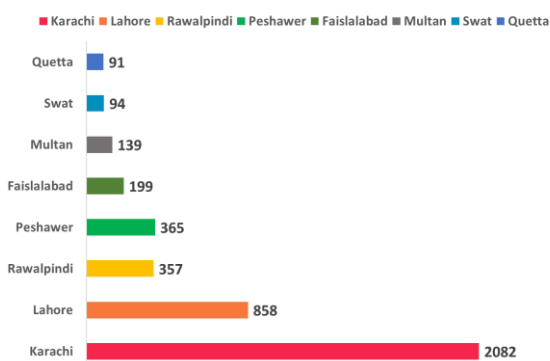
### Clinical Status of COVID



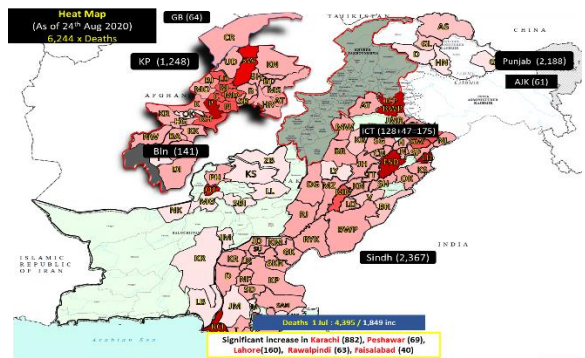

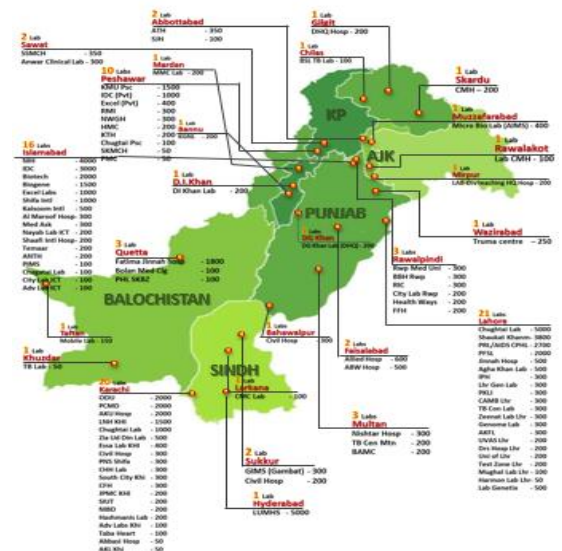
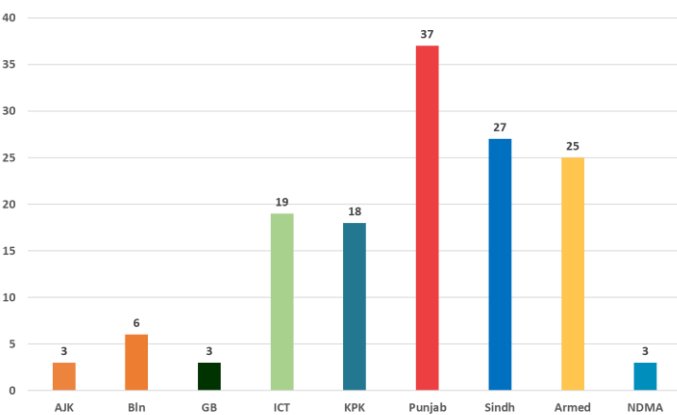

## 1. International

- a. WHO DG has thanked Canada for its support to COVAX initiative, a **mechanism designed to guarantee rapid, fair and equitable access to COVID vaccines worldwide.**
- b. **South Korea reported its highest daily increase in COVID cases** as authorities cautioned country was "on the brink of a nationwide pandemic".
- c. **Global death toll from COVID surpassed has 800,000.**
- d. **Former Ukrainian PM Yulia Tymoshenko has tested positive for COVID** and is reported to be in serious condition.
- e. **India's COVID cases have crossed three Mn mark** with 70,000 new infections.
- f. Chinese Premier Li Keqiang has said that **country's economy could grow this year, despite the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic.**
- g. WHO has said that **children aged 12 and over should wear masks to help tackle the COVID pandemic under the same conditions as adults**, while children between six and 11 should wear them on a risk-based approach.
- h. Russian Industry minister has said that they expect to produce **1.5 Mn and 2 Mn doses per month of its potential COVID vaccine by year end.**
- i. Italian Health Minister **government is not considering new lockdown to curb coronavirus infections.**
- j. **3 x COVID related studies across the world** have revealed links between low humidity as a key factor in spread of COVID, spread of COVID in Public restroom while flushing toilets and spread of COVID on Airborne dust particles.

## 2. National

- a. Punjab Health Minister has said that **59815 PCR tests have been conducted with only 0.16% positive.**
- b. **KP Government has paired up with the WB to educate tourists regarding COVID.**
- c. PM office has **urged people to follow the precautionary measures to stop a second wave of the coronavirus.**
- d. **Hotels in tourist hotspots Naran, Kaghan and Shouhgran have been sealed after staff tested positive for COVID.**
