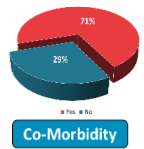
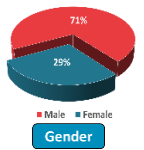
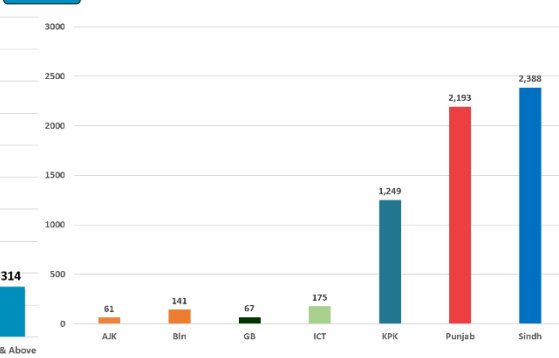


Death Analysis

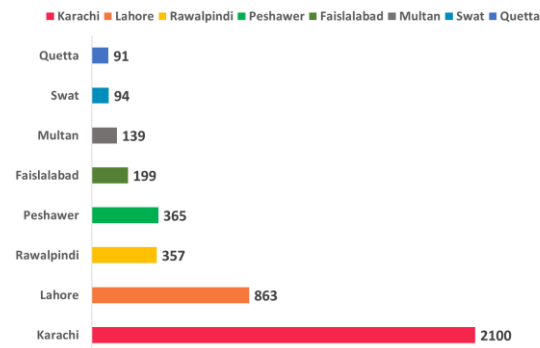

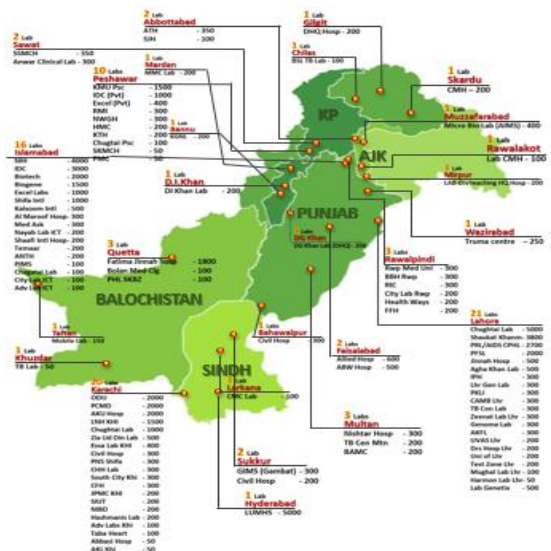
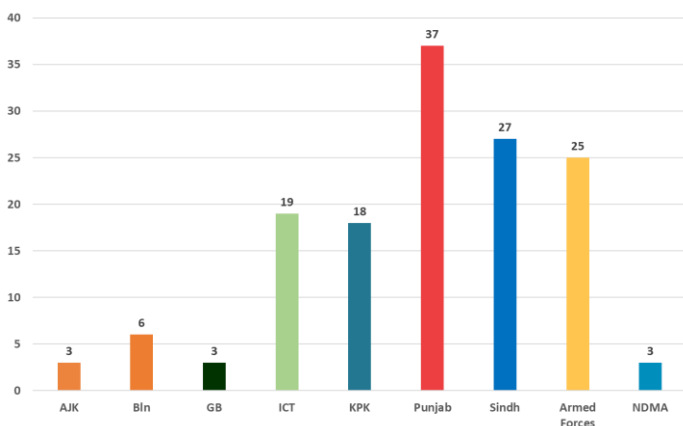


Heat Map

1. International

- a. US FDA's chief has **apologized for overselling plasma's benefits as a COVID-19 treatment.**
- b. University of Alabama (US) has reported more than **550 COVID positive cases amongst students, faculty and staff** since it resumed in-person classes.
- c. Spanish PM has said that troops would be made available to help areas overcome resurgence of COVID.
- d. **Myanmar shuts schools** after highest daily increase in COVID cases.
- e. Turkey's new COVID cases have increased to its highest level since mid-June at 1,502.
- f. Minister of Human Capacities Hungary has said that **based on fresh data on COVID, Hungary can reopen schools next week.**
- g. India's Central Bank Governor has cautioned that the **state-dominated banking system will need to push ahead with an infusion of funds to withstand the country's deepening COVID crisis.**
- h. **Sweden uncovers 3,700 false positives from COVID-19 test kit.**
- i. **South Korea has ordered doctors in Seoul to return to work as they began a three-day strike in protest of several government proposals**, including increasing the number of doctors.
- j. **Norway has said that it will impose a 10-day quarantine** on all people arriving from Germany.
- k. **Russia has decided to start a new phase of clinical trials of approved COVID vaccine** called "Sputnik V" that will involve more than 40,000 people in Moscow.
- l. French PM has said that government wants to **avoid a new nationwide lockdown due to COVID.**
- m. Gatwick Airport, (Britain) located south of London said it needed to **reduce 24% of its workforce because of travel slump caused by the COVID.**
- n. British military scientists have discovered that a **product found in insect repellent can kill the strain of coronavirus that causes COVID.**
- o. **Kazakhstan has signed a deal with Russia to get supplies of its first potential COVID vaccine** once clinical trials are complete.

2. National

- a. Department of **AGP has planned to audit all expenditures linked with COVID in country** to ensure transparency in the concerned departments.
- b. KP government has **devised strict SOPs of COVID for opening of schools from 15th of next month.**
- c. Punjab Governor Chaudhry Sarwar said **COVID has been defeated with the support of the nation and business community.**
- d. **Active COVID-19 cases drop below 10,000 in Pakistan.**
- e. **Punjab teachers to undergo COVID tests** before schools reopening.
