




Clinical Status of COVID















Heat Map

1. International

- a. The EU executive has urged its member states to **launch earlier and broader vaccination campaigns against flu to reduce the risk of simultaneous influenza and COVID outbreaks.**
- b. Philippines President has announced to enforce **partial COVID related restrictions in the capital for another two weeks**, and has warned that stricter curbs would be reinstated if the rise in new cases and deaths does not slow down.
- c. Venezuelan President has announced a **tightening of containment measures in the capital and neighboring states to try to halt the spread of the COVID.**
- d. **Belgium has postponed a further easing of rules on social gatherings after a surge in the number of COVID infections**, and the PM has said that she could not rule out the reintroduction of lockdowns in worst affected areas of country.
- e. BBC has said that **it would cut 520 jobs in its news operation which were put on hold due to the COVID pandemic.**
- f. Russian scientists have hailed **the results of their first clinical trial of a potential COVID vaccine saying it had been proved safe and that volunteers had developed an immune response.**
- g. **Japan has raised its COVID alert to the highest “red” level for its Capital on 15 Jul**, alarmed by a recent spike in daily new cases to record high.
- h. A prominent Japanese Government adviser has said that **the Tokyo Olympics may have to be postponed again if the novel COVID mutates into a stronger pathogen.**

2. National

- a. According to the report issued by the Ministry of National Health Services, Regulation and Coordination that **445 healthcare professionals have been tested positive for the COVID within past two weeks.**
- b. The Punjab Healthcare Department has said that **the Government laboratories will now send the virus test results to people via messages.**
- c. SAPM on Health Dr Zafar Mirza has said that **the polio vaccination campaign, which was halted due to COVID pandemic, will resume from 20 Jul.**
- d. Sindh Information Minister Nasir Hussain Shah has said **the provincial Government will make sure that there are no violations on the ban of weddings or large gatherings in the province due to the COVID pandemic.**
- e. **Vice Chancellor of Nishtar Medical University Dr Mustafa Kamal Pasha has passed away** due to COVID.

- f. Minister for Planning, Development and Special Initiatives Asad Umar has said that **the Government would provide 2,000 beds to hospitals by the end of July**, after several hospitals ran short of oxygenated beds amid sudden spike in COVID cases.
- g. Sindh government has extended the **province-wide COVID-19 lockdown restrictions till August 15**, in a bid to stem the infection from spreading.
- h. Health experts in the country have associated the **number of declining coronavirus cases in the country to the presence of a kind of “non-specific immunity” that is unique to the Pakistani people due to being exposed to various vaccines.**
