




Cases Vs Recovery



Clinical Status of COVID





Death Analysis

1. International

- a. Google has said that it will stop websites and apps that **use its advertising technology for promote conspiracy theories about the COVID pandemic**.
- b. UN Secretary General Antonio Guterres has said that **the COVID pandemic has exposed global inequality and "fractures in the fragile skeleton of the societies we have built"**.
- c. According to a Reuters tally, **for the first time there has been a surge of 1 million COVID cases in under 100 hours around the world**, as global infections has passed 14 million COVID cases on 17 Jul.
- d. As per official report and data, **US is losing about 5,000 people to the virus every week whereas, Canada has reported total 8,800 deaths since the pandemic outbreak**.
- e. A diplomat from an EU members state has said that **the chances of a deal on a COVID economic recovery scheme at a EU summit are "very slim"**.
- f. **The WHO has advised masses to avoid 3 Cs (Crowded places, Close-contact settings, Confined and enclosed spaces)** where the possibility of contracting the virus is high.
- g. France has announced to **enforce mask-wearing in enclosed public spaces including banks, shops and indoor markets from 20 Jul 20**, as part of its efforts to curb a resurgence of COVID across the country.
- h. Indonesia has announced to **increased tax incentives for businesses in a move to try and limit the economic impact of the COVID pandemic**.
- i. **Indonesia (84,882) surpassed China (83,664) in COVID tally cases**.
- j. China has launched **mass health screenings in Xinjiang after a spike in COVID cases raised fears of a fresh outbreak in the province**.
- k. Australian PM has delayed the **opening of parliament for several weeks as the new COVID infection continued spreading through the country**.
- l. Iranian President has said that **25 million Iranians have been infected with the COVID and that another 35 million are at risk of acquiring it**.

2. National

- a. **The NCOC held its first ever meeting in Sindh on 18 Jul**, which was co-chaired by Chairman Asad Umar and NCOC Coordinator Lt. General Hamood-uz-Zaman.

- b. Balochistan Government Spokesman Liaquat Shahwani has said that **COVID infection cases in the province are gradually decreasing due to smart lockdown policy.**
- c. PM has said that **his Government had fulfilled its promise to bring back stranded Pakistanis and overseas workers** and so far 250,000 stranded Pakistanis have returned home despite global air travel disruptions.
- d. SAPM on Health Dr Zafar Mirza has announced to **start Anti-Polio campaign from 20 Jul with strict implementation of COVID related SOPs.**
- e. **Sindh has reported 884 new COVID cases on 19 Jul since** (lowest number of new COVID cases since 4 Jun).
- f. Federal Minister Asad Umer has said that **Virus Pandemic can only be controlled with joint efforts of all provinces.**
- g. Sindh Information Minister Nasir Hussain Shah has said that **petrol pumps in the province will now be allowed to remain open 24 hours a day.**
- h. **14,772 recoveries (Highest number of recoveries) were reported on 18 Jun** as the number of recovered cases in the country has crossed 198,000.
