
Province-Wise COVID Cases





Death Analysis

1. International

- a. The Brazilian Olympic Committee has **reopened its training centres for participation in Japan Olympics**.
- b. With mass layoffs all over the world, **COVID expatriates in Dubai are now in a race to find new jobs amid the worsening economy**.
- c. For the first time in over half a century, **Nobel Prize banquet has been cancelled due to the COVID**.
- d. Major US and EU airlines have asked the EU and US to **consider a joint US-EU program to test airline passengers for COVID** as a way to allow people to travel once again between the US and Europe.
- e. Zimbabwe's President has said that **security forces would enforce a dusk to dawn curfew from 22 Jul to combat the COVID outbreak**.
- f. **Mumbai has turned to high tech "smart helmets" to speed up the screening process** of patients suspected to have the COVID.
- g. China's aviation authority has said that **passengers of China bound flights must provide COVID negative test results before boarding** to reduce the risk of imported COVID cases.
- h. South Korean epidemiologists have found that **people were more likely to contract the new COVID from members of their own households than from contacts outside the home**.
- i. Austria has announced that **face masks be worn in supermarkets, banks and post offices because of an increase in COVID infections** in recent weeks.
- j. **Afghan all girls robotics team has designed a low cost ventilator** to treat COVID patients.
- k. Microsoft Corp's professional networking site LinkedIn has said that **it would cut about 960 jobs (6% of its global workforce)** as the COVID pandemic is having a sustained impact on demand for its recruitment products.
- l. **South Korea's SK Bioscience has agreed to manufacture AstraZeneca's experimental COVID vaccine** to help the British company build global supplies of the vaccine that has shown promise against the new COVID.
- m. Saudi authorities have announced that **this year's Hajj will take place on 29 Jul with only 1,000 pilgrims**.
- n. As per experts of University of Oxford **possible COVID-19 vaccine could be rolled out** by the end of the year but there is no certainty that will happen.

- o. **McDonald's to reopen over 700** dine-in restaurants in UK.
- p. **France records 584 new COVID-19** cases in 24 hours, US records over 68,000 new virus cases in 24 hours.
- q. **Chinese mainland reports 14 new confirmed COVID19 cases**, including five imported cases, nine locally-transmitted ones.

2. **National**

- a. Sindh government spokesperson Murtaza Wahab has said that **the provincial Government has issued Rs. 25 million to Dar-ul-Sukoon "In addition to medicine & protective equipment.** 20 people at Dar-ul -Sukoon have been tested positive for COVID.
- b. Karachi and Islamabad city administration has **enacted Section 144 in both cities against illegally formed cattle markets ahead of Eid ul Adha.**
- c. Sindh Government spokesperson Murtaza Wahab has said that **the province has the lowest death rate and the highest recovery rate.**
- d. Punjab Government has announced that **Rawalpindi, Gujrat, Sialkot and Gujranwala will undergo a seven day smart lockdown till July 27th.**
- e. PM Focal person on COVID Dr Faisal Sultan has said **that the spread of COVID has lately been showing a downward trend in Pakistan which is one of the reasons for a drop in daily testing.**
- f. Punjab has **released the data and statistics of available facilities for COVID-19** patients on directives from Punjab Health Minister.
- g. SAPM on Health Dr Zafar Mirza has said that **the testing capacity for COVID is being further enhanced in the country.**
