



Clinical Status of COVID




1. International

- a. India has announced to cancel **a historic Hindu pilgrimage to a holy cave high in the snow-capped mountains of contested Kashmir for the first time** as cases of COVID are continued to rise.
- b. A WHO expert has said that **Researchers are making “good progress” in developing vaccines against COVID, with a handful in late-stage trials, but their first use cannot be expected until early 2021.**
- c. A group of UN rights experts has called on **Iran to immediately release jailed activist and journalist Narges Mohammadi, reportedly ill with the novel COVID, warning her life is at stake.**
- d. Spanish Tourism Minister has said that **a resurgence in COVID cases in country is expected to be under controlled and she hoped that there would be no need to close the border.**
- e. The US has signed **a 1.95 billion USD agreement with US Pharma Giant Pfizer and Germany's BioNTech for 100 million doses of their experimental COVID vaccine;** part of an aggressive push to start immunising Americans early next year.
- f. **Brazilian President Jair Bolsonaro has been tested positive for COVID** for the third time.
- g. Japan's travel ban aimed at stopping the spread of the COVID has **hit most European firms in the country and could prompt them to rethink their future in the world's third largest economy.**
- h. Tokyo Olympics organising committee chief executive Toshiro Muto has said that **they are preparing to host the Games next year even if the global COVID pandemic hasn't eased substantially.**
- i. **Global COVID infections have surged past 15 million cases with more than 629,000 deaths.**
- j. Head of the WHO's emergencies programme Mike Ryan has said that **worrying trends of COVID infection are emerging in southern Europe and in Balkan region.**
- k. Hong Kong has said that **it will expand strict new social distancing measures from 22 Jul, mandating face masks in all indoor public areas including malls and markets.**

2. National

- a. **A 103 year old man was discharged** from a hospital in Chitral **after beating COVID and fully recovering from the contagious disease.**
- b. A top Pakistani health expert Dr Tahir Sultan Shamsi has claimed that **by the first week of September 2020 around 65-70% of Karachi's population would be carrying COVID antibodies** as the country is moving towards herd immunity within the next two months.
- c. SAPM on Poverty Alleviation and Social Protection Dr Sania Nishtar has said that **cash has been granted to over 10 million families in a short time under Ehsaas Emergency Cash Programme.**
- d. SAPM on Health Dr Zafar Mirza has **appreciated the "commendable work by Punjab Government resulting in decline in cases and positivity".**
- e. The Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank's (AIIB) Board of Directors have approved **a loan of 250 million USD to help Pakistan strengthen its response to the social and economic fallout from the COVID pandemic.**
- f. PM has a telephonic conversation with Bangladeshi counterpart Sheikh Hasina to **express grief over the deaths caused by the deadly COVID in Bangladesh.**
- g. Balochistan Health officials has admitted that **there may be unrecorded COVID cases in province.**
- h. SAPM on overseas Pakistanis Sayed Zulfikar Bukhari has left for the UAE to **address and resolve the issue of Pakistani expats stranded in foreign country due to the COVID pandemic.**
