

Clinical Status of COVID





Death Analysis

1. International

- a. According to Reuters tally, **almost 40 countries have reported a record single day increase in COVID infection cases on 25 Jul.**
- b. **More than 280,000 new COVID cases have been reported globally on Thursday and Friday**, the highest daily rises since the virus emerged in China last year.
- c. UK has announced that **all travelers arriving in the UK from Spain will have to quarantine themselves for 14 days from 26 Jul** to ensure that they do not spread COVID.
- d. German Health Minister has said that **Germany may introduce compulsory COVID testing for holidaymakers returning from high risk destinations after the number of new infections in the country hit a two month high.**
- e. Iranian President has urged **people to observe health protocols and practice social distancing during upcoming Muslim festivities** due to a surge in COVID infections in a major holy city.
- f. **Brazilian President Jair Bolsonaro has been tested negative** for the new COVID.
- g. **The US has reported more than 1,000 deaths from COVID** for the fourth straight day on 24 Jul.
- h. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), **Young, healthy adults with mild COVID symptoms may also take weeks to recover.**
- i. Malaysia has said that **November summit of leaders from Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) nations might still go ahead in the capital**, despite the surge of cases due to COVID pandemic.
- j. **The WHO has expressed concern over a COVID resurgence in Europe** as Britain joined France, Germany and Austria in announcing tighter mask rules and greater testing.
- k. A survey of six countries has revealed **that Governments are fast losing support for their handling of the COVID outbreak from a public** that widely believes death and infection figures to be higher than statistics show.
- l. Greece has announced that **Visitors arriving to Greece by air from Bulgaria and Romania will need to provide proof they have been tested negative for COVID to gain entry in the country.**

2. **National**

- a. SAPM on Health Dr Mirza has urged everyone to **remain extra vigilant so that the decline in cases can be maintained.**
- b. The Galiyat Development Authority and Abbottabad district administration, in a joint operation has **sealed around 15 hotels and guesthouses in the galiyat for violating lockdown measures put in place to curb the COVID epidemic.**
- c. SAPM on Overseas Pakistanis Sayed Zulfiqar Bukhari has said that **"A part of our humanitarian efforts during COVID UAE has released and repatriate 1,200 prisoners"**.
- d. **The National Institute of Health has issued the guidelines for Eid-ul-Azha**, which will be observed on 1 Aug.
- e. SAPM on Health Dr Zafar Mirza has said that **health teams are conducting tests at cattle markets to enhance testing and to "sustain the COVID decline"**.
- f. SAPM for Overseas Pakistanis Sayed Zulfikar Bukhari has said that once the COVID pandemic subsides, **the UAE will give preference to Pakistanis in terms of employment opportunities.**
- g. Federal Minister for Education Shafqat Mahmood has said that the **Federal Government will review its decision to reopen schools in the first week of September.**
- h. Adviser to PM on Interior Mirza Shahzad Akbar has said that **the latest data released by the John Hopkins University has revealed a "marked decline" in the COVID cases in Pakistan in the past seven day.**
- i. SAPM on Youth Affairs Muhammad Usman Dar has said that **All-China Youth Federation has requested the Government of Pakistan to share operational details of the Prime Minister's COVID Relief Tiger Force.**
- j. The NDMA has clarified that **it has not received any donations from the US and Japanese Governments.**
- k. Balochistan Health Department has said that **the Quetta residents will get the testing facility for the COVID at their homes.**
- l. PCB Chief Executive has said that **"cricket and COVID-19 will have to co-exist"**.
- m. Federal Minister for Planning Asad Umar has **urged the masses to avoid going to the entertainment places and gatherings on Eid ul Adha.**
