## Cases Vs Recovery





1. **International**

- a. US officials have **accused Russian intelligence officers for spreading disinformation** about the COVID pandemic.
- b. Ukraine record its **highest daily increase of 1,197 new COVID cases**.
- c. India has **reported a record surge of 50,000 COVID cases** in the past 24 hours.
- d. **Death toll in US due to COVID crosses 150,000 mark**.
- e. **India's Hetero Labs Ltd has received regulatory approval to sell its version of anti-viral** drug for treating COVID.
- f. **British PM has cautioned a "second wave" in Europe** after a decision to quarantine all travellers arriving from Spain.
- g. German Research Minister has said that **COVID vaccine will not be widely available before the middle of next year**.
- h. **Bosnian minister for veteran's affairs has died after contracting COVID**.
- i. Russian state virology institute has started **human trials of country's second potential COVID vaccine**.
- j. **China has reported 105 new COVID cases**.
- k. **Israeli Supreme Court has ruled that Palestinian detainees** have no right to social distancing.
- l. International Air Transport Association has said that **global air traffic will not return to levels seen before COVID pandemic**.

2. **National**

- a. **US has donated 100 ventilators to the National Disaster Management Authority**.
- b. KP Health Minister has said that number of **COVID related deaths in KP have fallen from 133 per week to only 37 in the last week**.
- c. Chairman NDMA has said that **hospitals across the country are being upgraded to facilitate COVID patients**.
- d. **Governor Balochistan has urged people to follow SOPs** to curb the spread of COVID during Eid.
- e. **CM Balochistan has said that public cooperation for implementing SOPs is essential during Eid and Muharram** to mitigate the spread of the virus.
- f. Study conducted by Aga Khan University and Chinese University of Hong Kong has revealed that **people in Pakistan are less worried about COVID complications**.

- g. KPK health minister has said that **early decisions and smart lockdown strategy have reduced COVID cases.**
- h. President Dr Arif Alvi has said that **COVID cases declining in Pakistan due to government policies and public cooperation.**
- i. Dr Sania Nishtar has said that government has played a pivotal role in strengthening **health sector by enhancing testing capacity from 450 to 80,000 per day.**
