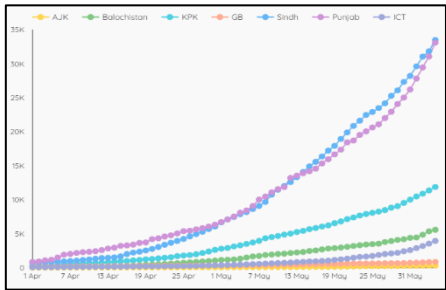

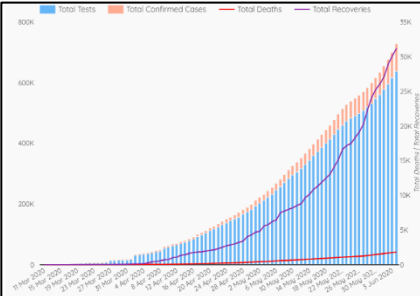

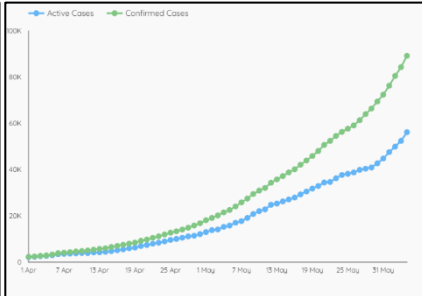

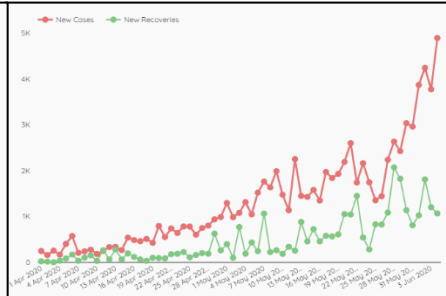

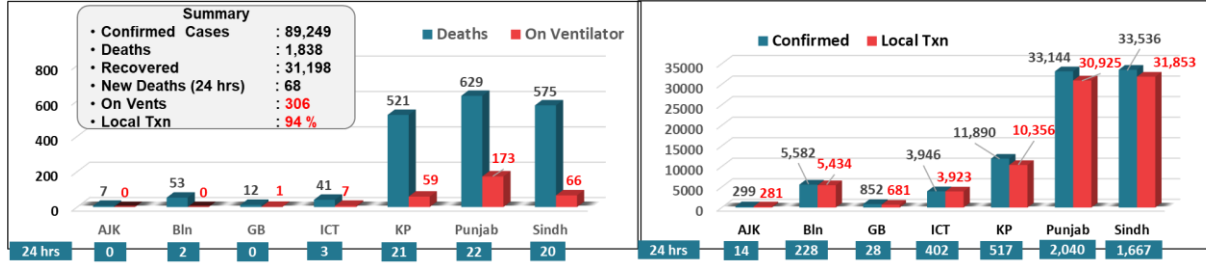
Active Cases Vs Confirmed Cases



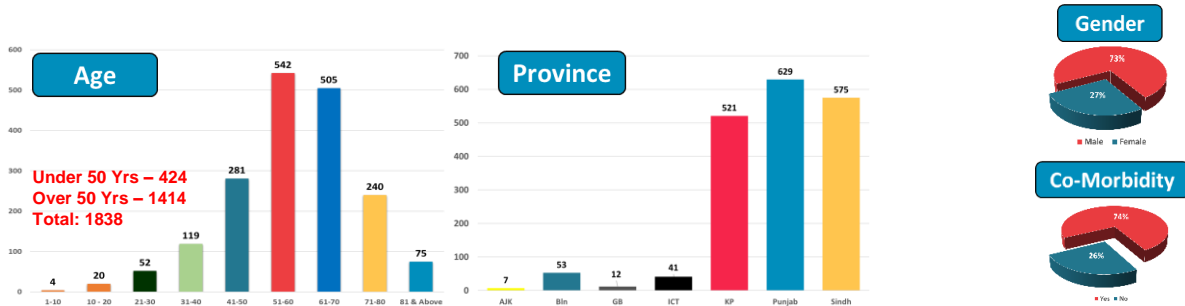
Cases Vs Recovery



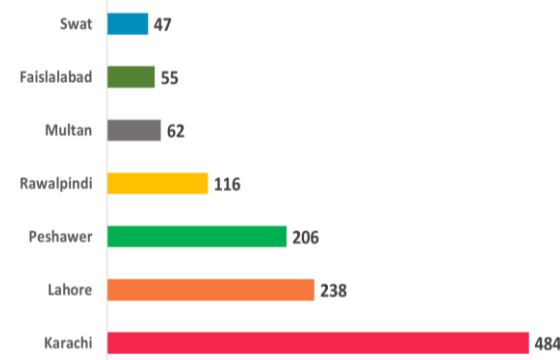

1. International

- a. China has denied news report claiming that **it has delayed sharing of COVID information with the World Health Organization (WHO)**.
- b. UN Economic and Social Council calls for urgent action to **help the growing number of countries facing “debt distress” because of the economic impact** of COVID pandemic.
- c. WHO has said that there are **133 potential COVID vaccines in development process around the world**.
- d. **China, India, Bangladesh among Asian nations accused by UN of censorship during pandemic**.
- e. UN General Secretary has said that despite the challenges, **refugees and migrants are contributing heroically to fight against COVID**.
- f. Scientists have reported after a clinical trial that **taking hydroxychloroquine shortly after being exposed to COVID doesn't help to prevent infection**.
- g. Belgium has announced to **re-open all business activities including opening of cafes and bars from 8 Jun**.
- h. US private companies have cut **2.76 million jobs in the month of May**, which were preceded by nearly 20 million in April amid COVID pandemic.
- i. Germany has announced to **lift COVID travel restrictions for European countries from 15 Jun**.
- j. **China tested almost 10 Mn people** in just over two weeks in Wuhan.

2. National

- a. Sindh government has issued **an advisory for Government offices to resume operations in the province**.
- b. Federal Government has decided to **hold a COVID prevalence survey. A pilot study, which will be completed in 2-3 weeks, is in progress in the federal capital before the launch of a nationwide study** by mid-Jun to get data from across the country.
- c. **20 Special Security Unit (SSU) commandos of Sindh Police, recovered from COVID have donated blood plasma**.
- d. British envoy meets SAPM on Health to **exchange views on the eve of the virtual Global Vaccines Summit hosted by the UK**.
- e. Information and Broadcasting Minister has warned that **strict lockdown will be imposed and ensured if people continued to ignore the SOPs**.
- f. Sindh has conducted **7,547 COVID tests (highest number of tests conducted in last 24 hrs) against which 1,824 (24.2%) were diagnosed positive**.

- g. **9 areas have been sealed by Islamabad administration to contain the spread of COVID** in capital territory.
- h. **PML (N) MPA Shaukat Manzoor has passed away** due to COVID.
- i. SBP has launched **dedicated page to share the progress and key data on the measures taken to counter the impact of COVID**.
- j. **240 stranded Pakistanis have been repatriated from Saudi Arabia** via PIA special flight on 3 Jun.
- k. **Pakistan has crossed China with respect to higher number of COVID positive cases.**
