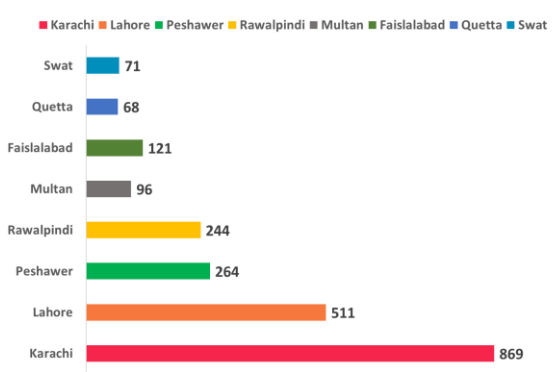
### Clinical Status of COVID



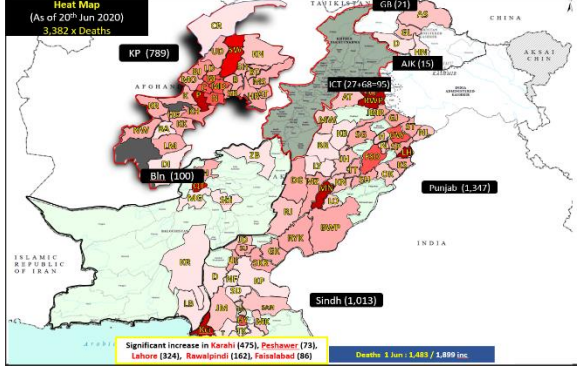
### Death Analysis

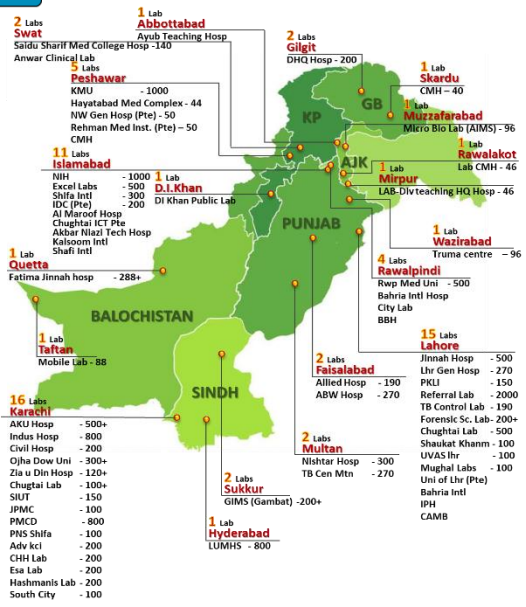
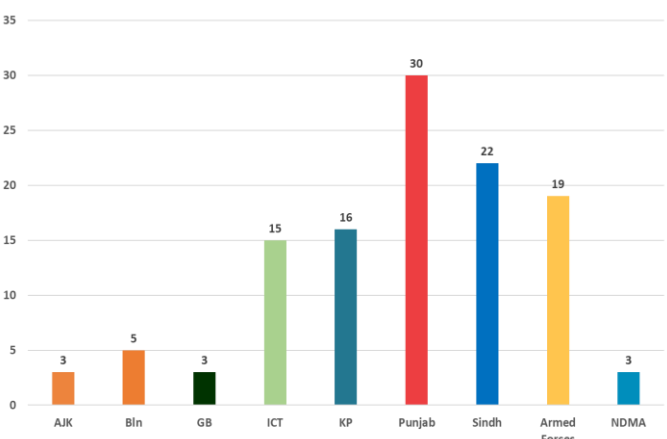


### Heat Map

## 1. International

- a. US president has said that **country will not be locked** if COVID spreads again.
- b. WHO has said that a **second wave of COVID could hit in autumn** and urged countries to step up track and trace schemes.
- c. US researchers have said that **China's deaths due to COVID could be 14 times bigger** than official data.
- d. South Africa has decided to **ease COVID lockdown measures** despite increase in COVID cases.
- e. Britain has decided to **switch to google and apple tech for COVID contact tracing app**.
- f. Russian health watchdog has revealed that **500 health care workers have died due to COVID**.
- g. Russian energy minister has said that **COVID pandemic will accelerate shift away from hydrocarbons**.
- h. Scotland has made **face coverings mandatory in public transport**.
- i. Kuwait has announced to **ease curfew hours from 21 Jun**.
- j. Slovenia has announced **14 days quarantine for people** returning back from Serbia, Bosnia and Kosovo.
- k. IMF has said that **US economy may face an even worse contraction in second quarter**.
- l. The Spanish government has announced **4.82 billion USD plan to support its tourism industry**.
- m. KSA petroleum company Aramco has **started laying off its employees, as demand for fuel has reduced worldwide**.
- n. **Australia's T-20 International with Scotland** cancelled due to COVID.

## 2. National

- a. PM Imran Khan has **ordered action against nine OMCs** including cancellation of their licenses and arrest of officials found in fuel crises.
- b. Sindh provincial government has imposed **2-weeks lockdown in areas identified as hotspots in Sindh**.
- c. SBP has said that **foreign exchange reserves held by central bank have increased by 0.11%** compared to previous week.
- d. **GB Agriculture minister Janbaz Khan has died due to COVID**.
- e. KP provincial health minister has said that **176 beds have been added to public hospitals in past 10 days**.

- f. PIA has announced **30% reduction in air cargo tariff** to add country exports and foreign earnings.
- g. PM Imran Khan has **directed federal and all provincial authorities to take all possible steps for controlling COVID.**
- h. PM has directed **educational authorities for devising a strategy to restore academic activities** in the country in consultation with provinces.
- i. PCB Chairman has said that **the T20 World Cup in Australia this year seems “impossible” due to the challenges of COVID.**
- j. PIA has said that **100,000 stranded Pakistanis have been repatriated in largest relief flight operation in Pakistan's history.**
- k. Chairman CPEC has said that **despite COVID pandemic, progress on multi-billion-dollar project has not been hampered.**
- l. **The Headquarters of the FIA Cyber Crime Wing was sealed** after three employees were tested positive for COVID.
- m. Punjab Healthcare Commission (PHCC) **has cautioned private hospitals to reduce their rate.**
- n. Punjab CM has ordered private labs to stick to fixed rates for COVID-19 tests.
- o. **Pakistan extends foreigners' visa validity till 31<sup>st</sup> Aug.**
