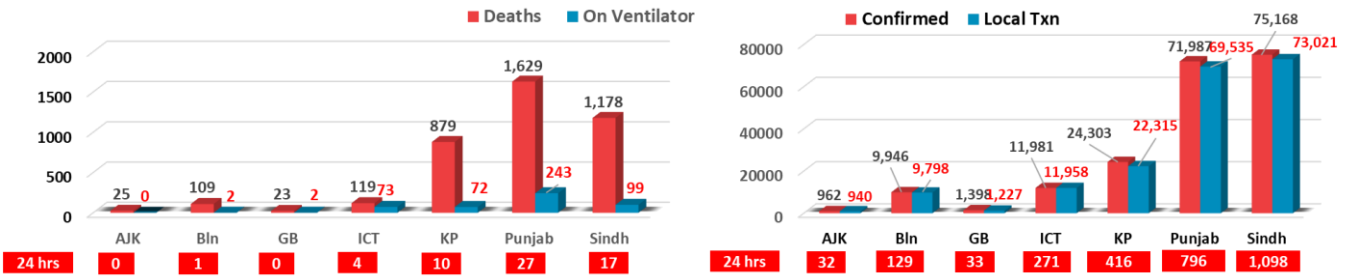

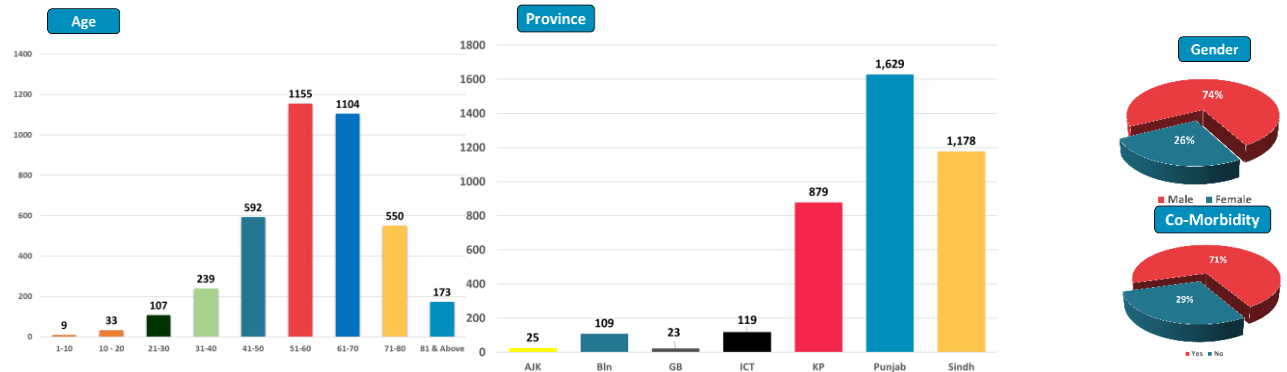
Cases Vs Recovery



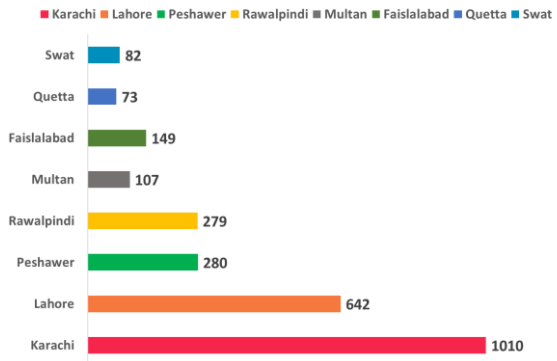
Clinical Status of COVID



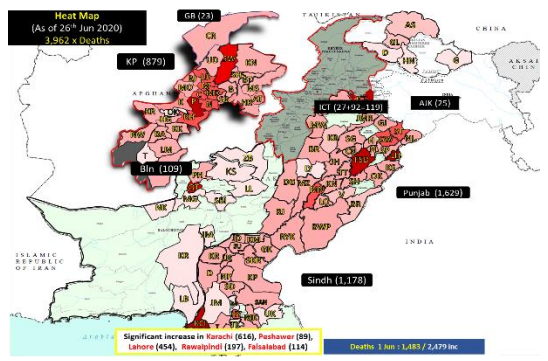
Death Analysis

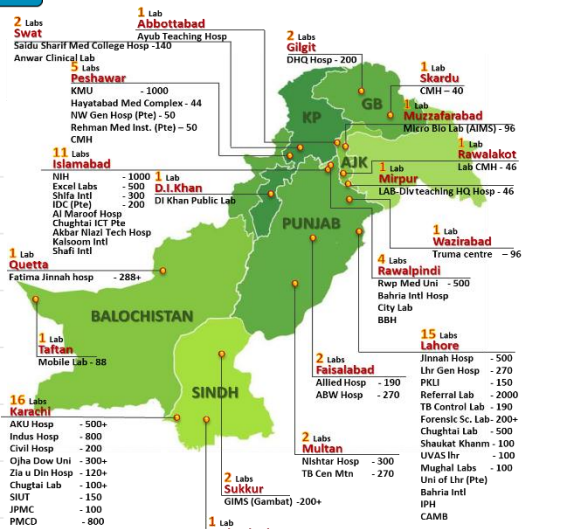
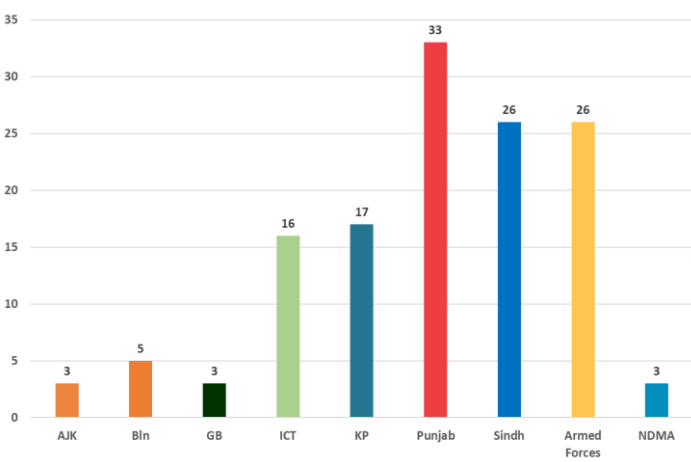


Heat Map

1. International

- a. NY City has **begun Phase-2 of reopening**.
- b. US has recorded **highest number of new COVID cases (40,184) in a single day since outbreak of pandemic**.
- c. WHO Director General has said that **number of COVID cases around the world would reach 10 Mn by next week**.
- d. Croatia has announced to **reintroduce a mandatory 14-day quarantine for visitors from Bosnia, Kosovo, North Macedonia and Serbia**.
- e. IMF has said that **KSA's economy will shrink by 6.8% this year due to COVID pandemic**.
- f. Authorities in Israel and Palestine have **re-imposed COVID restrictions after an increase in COVID cases**.
- g. Belgium has announced to further ease COVID lockdown restrictions on 1 July, **allowing swimming pools, theme parks and party venues to reopen**.
- h. China has claimed that **new COVID outbreak of infection in Beijing is under control**.
- i. **Bangladesh has formally called off their test series in Sri Lanka** because of the COVID pandemic.
- j. Airport authorities in UK have cautioned that **20,000 jobs are at risk due to travel restriction in the country**.
- k. World Bank health expert has cautioned that **lives of Mns of women and children in poor countries are at risk due to the COVID**.

2. National

- a. Punjab Government has announced to **seal seven more areas in Lahore to contain spread of COVID**.
- b. **PM has approved the launch of "Corona Relief Tiger Force" mobile app** to fight against COVID.
- c. Medical Superintendent Dr Javed Munir has said that **Allama Iqbal Teaching Hospital has established a new ICU ward with 200 beds**.
- d. **The WB has approved 236 Mn USD grant and credit to support Pakistan's efforts to enhance learning and healthcare and address COVID pandemic in the country**.
- e. PM Imran Khan has said that **burden on hospitals will increase if SOPs are not followed**.

- f. Pakistan has received **1 Bn USD from ADB and WB for overcoming the shortfall in budget expenditure** and counter COVID in an effective manner.
- g. **Government has decided to convert locusts into organic fertilizers.**
- h. KP provincial livestock department has allowed **cattle markets to operate in the province** subjected to COVID SOP adherence.
