







9. International

- a. **COVID cases re-emerged in China**, one city in Jilin province reclassified as high-risk zone.
- b. **Iran arrested at least 320 people** for allegedly spreading “false and provocative” information on the coronavirus.
- c. More than **90 % of hospital beds earmarked for COVID-19 patients in Tokyo** have already been occupied.
- d. **US president said he is pushing forward to reopen** the U.S. after the pandemic forced “artificially induced unemployment”.
- e. India is planning to **reopen partial trains operations** under COVID safety protocol.
- f. **KSA plans to triple its Value Added Tax (VAT) and halt monthly handout payments** to citizens amid COVID led economic slump.
- g. World Bank urged **food security be a priority** in South Asia due to heavy population.
- h. **Iran warned spike in its Southwest region** despite fall in other regions.
- i. Study finds that patients with a **deficiency of vitamin-D are twice susceptible to die from COVID-19.**
- j. More than 100 countries approached IMF for emergency assistance.
- k. WFP warns that COVID-19 pandemic could provoke famines.
- l. **Russia's COVID cases rise by more than 10,000** for sixth consecutive day.

10. National

- a. Pakistan Army officer (**Major Muhammad Asghar**) **deployed at the Torkham border terminal embraced shahadat** due to coronavirus.
- b. With over 30,000 cases, **Pakistan now 19th most affected country in the world.**
- c. **Five hospitals including three in Sindh formally started clinical trials of passive immunization** process for treatment of COVID-19.
- d. Federal Minister Asad Umar said the **government would use technology to trace COVID-19 patients and identify virus hotspots in the country** as part of its ‘smart lockdown’ strategy.
- e. **Two members of the National Assembly and attendant of the parliament lodges** tested positive for Covid-19.
- f. PIA’s flight carrying **sixth consignment of medical and safety equipment** reached Pakistan from China today.
- g. Pakistan’s oil and gas sector suffered **losses over Rs 51 bn in April following a decrease in energy demand.**
- h. Punjab Govt decided to **extend lockdown in 6 x major Districts while in 15 x Districts lockdown** is normalized, will be reviewed on 18 May for effects.
