9. International

- a. Saudi Arabia has announced to enforce **24-hour lockdown from 23 to 27 May during Eid ul Fitr.**
- b. **Russia has opened its factories and construction sector** after a six-week lockdown despite **ranking high in global COVID tally.**
- c. Russian President's Spokesperson has **tested positive for COVID.**
- d. US Government infectious disease experts have warned that **COVID deaths and economic damage will rise** if lockdown is lifted too fast.
- e. UN has cautioned that **6000 children could die every day** due to impact of COVID on health services.
- f. Japan is expected to approve its **first COVID antigen diagnostic kit** in an attempt to boost the number of test available.
- g. CIA has accused China of **threatening WHO if COVID was declared as a global health emergency.**
- h. India has announced **264 bn USD economic package** to help the country cope with its prolonged COVID lockdown.
- i. **93 children in US have been diagnosed with inflammatory disease** linked with COVID.
- j. US treasury department has announced a **budget deficit of 737.9 bn USD for the month of April.**
- k. National Research Council Canada and Chinese biotechnology company have agreed on a **joint venture for developing COVID vaccine Ad5-nCoV** in Canada.
- l. Toyota Motors Corporation has said that their **profit will drop by 80 % by the end of this year** due to impact of COVID.
- m. WHO has stated that **smokers are more vulnerable to COVID-19 than non-smokers.**
- n. More than **141 Japanese companies have been bankrupted** due to COVID.

10. National

- a. Ministry of Food and Agriculture has prepared a **relief package worth Rs 37 Bn for subsidizing Urea and DAP** that would directly benefit farmers.
- b. Balochistan Private School Association has announced **reopening of schools from 1st June** and rejected the proposal for promotion of students to next grade.
- c. 285 COVID cases have been **diagnosed in Punjab Police.**
- d. Sindh Agriculture minister has said that **Government has enhanced the capacity to fight Locust by adding 41 more teams.**
- e. Punjab Minister for Industries and Trade has cautioned that **government would re-impose the lockdown if traders do not follow the SOPs.**
- f. Pakistan Steel Mill has accused Sindh Government of utilizing its land for **burial of COVID patients.**
- g. **150 Pakistani students** stranded in US have departed for Lahore.
