9. International

- a. WHO said that COVID-19 **“may never go away”** and may become endemic.
- b. UK has approved **100 % accurate antibody test** that is able to diagnose if a patient was exposed to COVID-19.
- c. WHO’s chief scientist has cautioned **COVID-19 could take four to five years to bring under control.**
- d. **China has put its second city Jilin under lockdown** after emergence of COVID clusters.
- e. UN has stated that **COVID-19 has caused widespread psychological distress worldwide.**
- f. Brazil has reported **record number of COVID cases 11,385 in 24 hours.**
- g. US and Canada are expected to **extend their ban on non-essential air travel up till 21st June.**
- h. Russian Health Minister has announced that **Russia will start clinical trial of COVID-19 vaccine in June.**
- i. WHO’s envoy to Russia has stated that **lifting of lockdown may lead to a new COVID-19 spike.**
- j. **UKs death toll crosses 40,000, worst in Europe.**
- k. Over 300 lawmakers around the world have urged, IMF and WB to cancel the debts of poor countries.

10. National

- a. Chinese Medical Military Team visited the National Institute of Health (NIH) Islamabad on 14 May 2020. **Executive Director of NIH, Maj Gen Dr. Aamer Ikram briefed the team about response to COVID-19.**
- b. Pakistan sees a **record jump in COVID-19 cases after easing of lockdown.**
- c. Pakistan has managed to **retain its MSCI emerging market status** despite fears of downgrade due to COVID pandemic.
- d. **Trade activities between Pakistan and Iran** have resumed via Taftan.
- e. **Balochistan finance minister** has tested positive for COVID.
- f. TEVTA chairperson has informed that it has **distributed 60,000 masks, 600 PPEs and other medical supplies** to district governments across Punjab.
- g. Sindh home department has issued a notification **prohibiting all religious rallies, processions and gathering in the province.**
- h. Sindh Government has decided to **promote matric and intermediate students without exams.**
- i. **COAS has directed commanders in Baluchistan to reach out for people in far flung areas** to mitigate challenges faced due to COVID pandemic.
- j. Pakistan Army **distributed rations among the coronavirus affected areas** in Khuzdar district of Balochistan.
