9. International

- a. Medical agency for the European Union states **that vaccine to counter COVID could be approved in about a year in an “optimistic” scenario.**
- b. China said that it will step up COVID-19 testing and screening to prevent a rebound of the COVID pandemic **that has killed more than 4,600 in its mainland territories.**
- c. China has tested over 3 million residents of Wuhan since April, **and will now focus its testing efforts on the rest of its 11 million population.**
- d. Pakistan's trade has benefited from the EU's GSP Plus agreement; **this will facilitate in current economic situation of the country amid COVID.**
- e. **Public Health Department England has approved antibody COVID diagnostic test developed by Abbott labs** that is able to diagnose COVID with 100 % accuracy.
- f. US Immunologist Dr Sean Tucker will start **Human Trials of COVID vaccine in July that is taken by tablet** instead of injection.
- g. A team of international researchers have claimed that **mouth wash liquid can be used to prevent COVID.**
- h. WHO has warned that Europe could be hit by a second **wave of COVID in autumn.**
- i. **Head of WTO Roberto Azevedo has stepped down** due to COVID impact on global economy and US criticism.
- j. WHO has cautioned that **250 Mn Africans could be infected by COVID.**
- k. Two Rohingya have been tested positive for COVID-19 **in world's largest refugee camp.**
- l. US commission has expressed concern over **India's arrest of Muslim activists during COVID crisis** who protested against CAA.
- m. UNICEF states that mental health and well being of entire communities have been severely impacted by COVID-19, **children and young people are particularly at risk.**

10. National

- a. PM Imran Khan has said that **smuggling and hoarding pose a serious threat to food security and will be dealt with iron hands.**
- b. Lahore district administration has **sealed 215 shops over violation of COVID SOPs.**
- c. Pakistan Automotive Manufacturers Association (PAMA) have revealed that **three big automobile companies did not sell a single vehicle for the month of April.**
- d. Foreign Minister Shah Mehmood Qureshi has stated that **growth of COVID in Pakistan is not exponential but economic challenge is grave.**
- e. Dr Zafar Mirza announced that **US company Gilead has given a voluntary license to Pakistani drug company for manufacture of remdesivir for COVID patients** in Pakistan and also export to 127 other countries.
