9. **International**

- a. **Al-Aqsa Mosque will be reopened** to worshippers after the Eid holidays.
- b. Iran called for **global solidarity against the pandemic**, but said that unilateral sanctions are “inhumane” and causing “unnecessary suffering and pain” to its population.
- c. **India recorded its highest number of deaths** (146 in a single day) raising the total death tally to 3,302.
- d. Nigeria will impose **“precision” lockdown measures in areas that report rapid increases in COVID cases**.
- e. An American company, Moderna, announced that **initial human trials of its COVID vaccine has produced COVID antibodies in its subjects**.
- f. Singapore has announced **limited easing of lockdown from 2 Jun**.
- g. The President of World Bank has warned that **60 Mn people could be pushed into extreme poverty due to COVID**.
- h. Brazil recorded its **highest daily death rise of 1,179 deaths due to COVID**.
- i. Thailand has claimed that it will **produce COVID vaccine by end of this year**.
- j. Kuwait and Qatar started strict measures including jailing and fines for not **wearing of facemasks in public**.

10. **National**

- a. Prime Minister Imran Khan, in an online session of the World Economic Forum (WEF), called upon the developed countries to **provide debt relief to poorer nations that were struggling to cope with the COVID crisis**.
- b. MPA Punjab Assembly Mrs Shaheen Raza passed away on 20 May and was laid to rest **according to the COVID burial protocols** released by the government.
- c. **The Chinese Embassy presents ‘Care Packages’ among needy families of Peshawar and Rawalpindi** during Ramazan amid COVID to help the underprivileged to overcome the temporary challenge.
- d. Pakistan’s Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) has increase by **32 % (133.2 million USD) for the month of April despite COVID pandemic**.
- e. Pakistan and WB have signed loan agreements of **371 million USD for supporting projects in the agriculture and social sectors**.
- f. Supreme Court has said that **decision for reopening of shopping malls and markets will be reviewed** after Eid holidays.
- g. More than **200 prisoners have been tested positive** for COVID at Karachi Central Jail.
- h. **Balochistan government has announced to extend lockdown till 2 Jun** for containing spread of COVID cases.
