





5. Clinical Status of COVID Cases



6. Category of COVID Spread




7. Analysis of Death Cases – 440 Deaths

9. International

- a. **100 Sailors from US Navy** destroyer USS Kidd have been **tested positive for COVID**.
- b. **Research carried out by University of East Anglia and Queen Elizabeth hospital UK** indicates, people with low levels of vitamin D are more likely to die after contracting COVID.
- c. **Philippines has released approximately 10,000 prisoners** to control the spread of COVID.
- d. **India has reported biggest rise in COVID cases** (2,239) in a **single day**.
- e. US military scientists have designed a blood test that can **identify carriers of COVID disease before they are infectious or show symptoms**.
- f. Japan's extended state of **emergency** for **about a month**.
- g. **Malls are reopening in the US** from COVID lockdowns, leaving business owners, workers and consumers to decide what normal means now.
- h. "Five Eyes" intelligence Alliance (UK, USA, Australia, New Zealand & Canada) has claimed that **China's secrecy over the pandemic is an "assault on international transparency"**.
- i. **Indian Navy is utilizing its Landing Platform Dock warship INS JALASHWA and two amphibious** warships for evacuating Indian citizens from Gulf.
- j. WHO in a statement has assured **that COVID is natural in origin**.
- k. **Dogs are being trained to detect people with COVID**, experimental trials underway in UK and USA.

10. National

- a. **Sindh businessmen association** has demanded that **Sindh Government** should **ease the lockdown after 15th of Ramazan**.
- b. State Bank of Pakistan has enhanced the financing limit from **Rs 200 Mn to Rs 500 Mn for single hospital / medical centre** under its Refinance Facility for combating COVID.
- c. **Inflation rate for the month of April has fallen to 8.5%** due to subdued demand amid pandemic lockdown.
- d. SAPM on Poverty Alleviation and Social Safety has said that Rs 83.25 billion had been distributed **amongst 6.82 million beneficiaries under Ehsaas Emergency Cash Program**.
- e. Government of Balochistan has cautioned that **complete lockdown will be imposed in the province** amid surge in locally transmitted cases.
