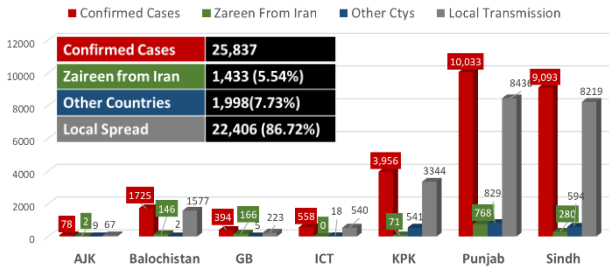

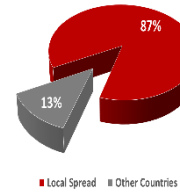
#### 5. Clinical Status of COVID Cases



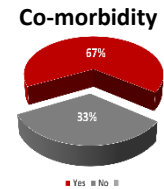
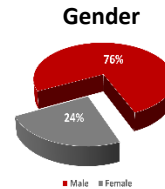
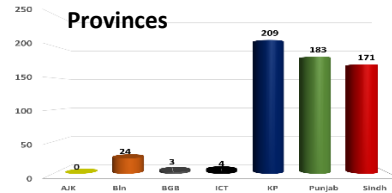
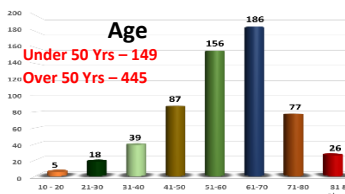
#### 6. Category of COVID Spread

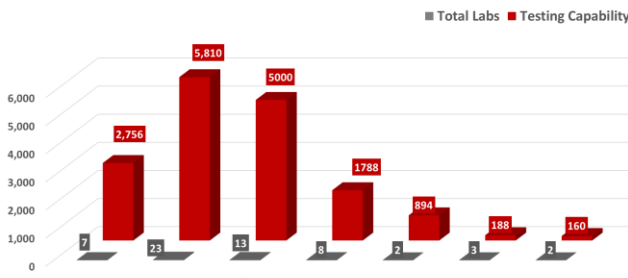


#### 7. Analysis of Death Cases – 594 Deaths

## 9. International

- a. UK has become the first country in Europe to **surpass 30,000 COVID deaths.**
- b. According to research carried out by European Commission, **Europe's economy is expected to shrink by 7.4% this year.**
- c. Britain's PM has stated that **COVID lockdown will be eased on 11 May.**
- d. UK authorities have revealed that a **new deadly inflammatory syndrome in children is caused by COVID.**
- e. US President has declared COVID pandemic **as the "worst attack" on US.**
- f. **More than 450 individuals of Indian State police** have been tested positive for COVID.
- g. WHO has cautioned the risk of easing of lockdown if countries do not **manage the transition period carefully and in a phased manner.**
- h. China has stated that **US Secretary of State does not have any evidence in support of his claim** that COVID originated in China.
- i. **Brazil has started to emerge as the new Epi centre** with 600 deaths on 7<sup>th</sup> May.
- j. **Dutch scientists have claimed** finding a virus fighting antibody.
- k. Israel's Biological Research Institute confirmed that it has **isolated an antibody that could be used to develop treatments against COVID.**
- l. Britain and US issued a joint warning on **cyber-attacks against health professionals involved in coronavirus response.**

## 10. National

- a. NCC has approved **gradual easing of lockdown restrictions after 9<sup>th</sup> May.**
- b. Pakistan has expressed concerns over the quantum **of COVID spread in its workers being repatriated from UAE.**
- c. **Ministry of Finance and State Bank of Pakistan introduced a risk sharing mechanism** for supporting SMEs and small businesses under SBPs Refinance Facility to Support Employment.
- d. Punjab, Balochistan and Sindh provinces have **opposed opening of educational institutions from 1<sup>st</sup> June.**
- e. NCOC approves health **SOPs to address concerns arising out of easing in lockdown.**
