9. International

- a. White House staff in US will be tested on daily basis after a **military official with US President was tested positive**.
- b. Senior Health Reporter from UK has revealed that **US antiviral drug Remdesivir could cost 4,500 USD**, despite having a manufacturing price USD of 9.32.
- c. **Poland's presidential polls have been postponed** due to COVID pandemic.
- d. **US economy has lost 22 mn jobs** for the month of April 2020 due to COVID.
- e. Vietnam have claimed to contain COVID outbreak **due to mass testing**.
- f. WHO has stated that around **83000-190,000 people would die from COVID in Africa**.
- g. Saudi Arabia has formed a police unit for **monitoring violations of COVID lockdown**.
- h. World Tourism Organization has said that **international tourism could drop by 60 – 80 % in 2020**.
- i. **Sydney University has predicted that suicide cases in Australia will increase by 25 – 50 %** due to Financial and Psychological stress of COVID crises.
- j. South Korean health authorities have revealed that **350 COVID re-infected people have appeared to be "false positives"**.
- k. **61 year old British Pakistani Cancer Specialist dies in UK** due to COVID.
- l. **UN has appealed for USD 4.7 bn more to fight COVID pandemic**, especially for the 20 countries including Pakistan and Afghanistan.
- m. **Russia has planned to ease restrictions in three stages**, first, allowing people for walk, secondly, opening of educational institutions, services and business sector while Parks and squares are being reopened in third stage.
- n. Turkey has offered its expertise to Pakistan in its fight against locust **and handed over a purpose-built Piper Brave spray aircraft along with four crew members to PAF**.

10. National

- a. **PM Imran Khan announced that NCC has decided to end COVID-19 lockdown** in a multiple phase from 9th May.
- b. Minister of Foreign Affair Shah Mehmood Qureshi has stated that **Government is expecting the peak of COVID crises by end of May or in early June**.
- c. **PM Imran Khan and Nigerian President Muhammadu Buhari in a telephonic conversation** discussed socio-economic challenges arising out of COVID pandemic.
- d. Balochistan has extended the **lockdown period till 19 May**.

- e. **Province disagree on opening of educational institutions** amid increase in spread of COVID.
- f. **Pakistan's oil and gas sector has suffered over Rs 51 bn** in April following a decrease in energy demand amid COVID lockdown.
- g. **State Bank of Pakistan reports increase of 2.15 % (USD 259 mn)** in foreign exchange reserves compared with previous week.
- h. Pakistan has recorded its biggest increase of **1764 confirmed COVID cases in a single day**.
