




Cases Vs Recovery




Clinical Status of COVID




Death Analysis





Heat Map

1. International

- a. President Vladimir Putin has ordered **Russian authorities to begin mass voluntary vaccinations against COVID-19 next week.**
- b. Ukraine Prime Minister has said that it has **lifted weekend lockdown restrictions** in place to fight the spread of the coronavirus
- c. World Health Organisation has **recommended wearing facemasks when indoors** with other people, if the ventilation has been deemed inadequate.
- d. Researchers from North Carolina State University in US have said **that Chocolate and green tea could help against COVID-19.**
- e. Interpol global police co-ordination agency has cautioned that organised criminal networks could be targeting COVID-19 vaccines, and could **sell fake shots.**
- f. Pfizer and BioNTech have said that they've **won permission for emergency use of their COVID-19 vaccine in Britain.**
- g. US CDC has updated its guidelines pertaining to people who have been exposed to COVID can **cut their time in quarantine in half** if they test negative for the virus and report no symptoms.
- h. WHO expert has said that it does not believe there will be **enough supplies of COVID vaccines** in the next three to six months to prevent a surge in the number of infections.
- i. EU has urged countries to **reinforce their healthcare systems and coordinate restrictions on social gatherings** ahead of the Christmas holiday season.
- j. Poland has signed a contract with **Pfizer, BioNTech, AstraZeneca and Johnson and Johnson for 45 Mn Covid-19 vaccine doses.**
- k. A senior executive BioNTech has said that it will **send the COVID-19 vaccine it has developed with Pfizer in temperature-controlled boxes to Britain.**
- l. WHO has said that it had received data from Pfizer and BioNTech on the COVID-19 vaccine and was reviewing it for **possible listing for emergency use.**
- m. Britain's health secretary has said that Brexit has helped Britain accelerate the **landmark rollout of a COVID-19 vaccine.**
- n. Poland's health ministry has said that **it has crossed 1 Mn COVID cases mark.**
- o. Italian health minister has said that Italy will **launch a free COVID vaccination programme early next year.**
- p. Russia has suffered its **worst daily death toll since the pandemic began,** reporting 589 deaths in the last 24 hours.

- q. UK's Department of Health and Social Care has said that vaccine developed by Pfizer and BioNTech will be **available in the UK from next week.**

2. **National**

- a. Punjab government has **banned indoor dining at all restaurants** in the province, while eateries will be allowed to serve customers outdoors only.
- b. Sindh Chief Minister Murad Ali Shah has **tested negative for COVID-19.**
- c. Parliamentary Secretary for National Health Services Regulations and Coordination (NHSRC) Dr Nausheen Hamid said **COVID-19 vaccine, once procured, will be administered to citizens free of cost.**
- d. Dr Mohammad Farooq, additional director of Khalifa **Gulnawaz teaching Hospital, Bannu**, has passed away due to complications caused by COVID-19.
- e. Pakistan has reported **more than 2,000 coronavirus recoveries** during the last 24 hours.
- f. NCOC has announced that **Pakistan will observe SOPs compliance week from December 5-12**
