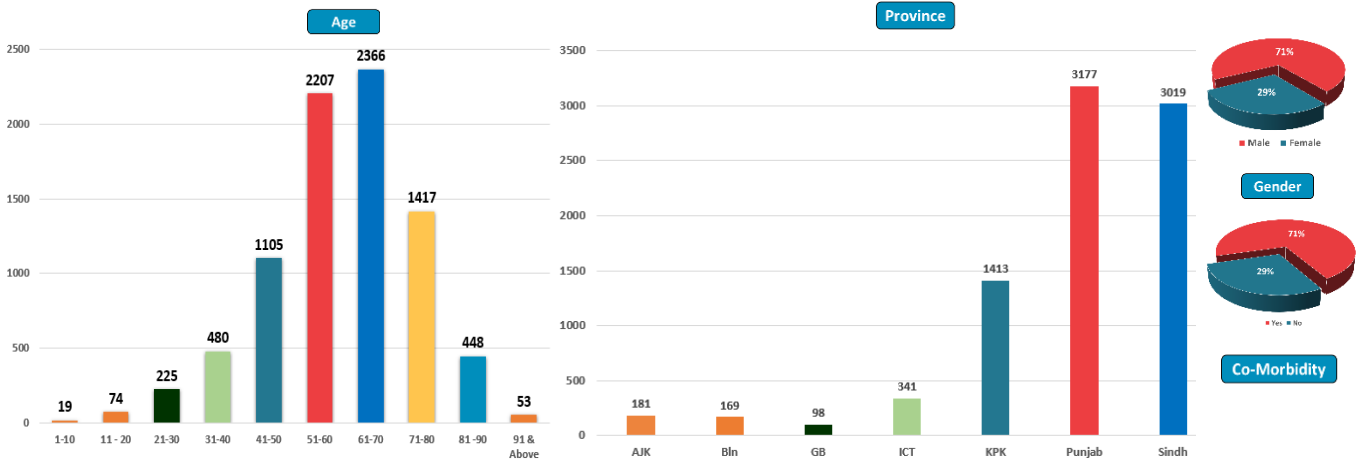
## Cases Vs Recovery



### Clinical Status of COVID

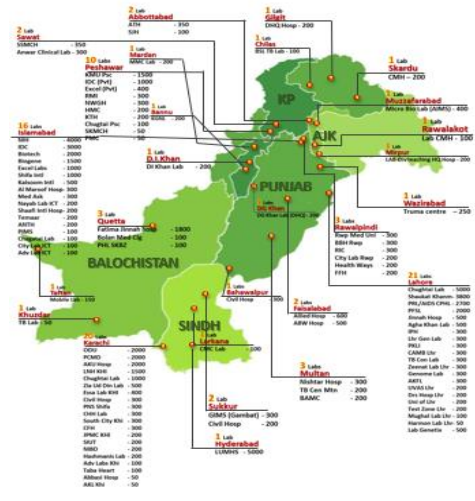
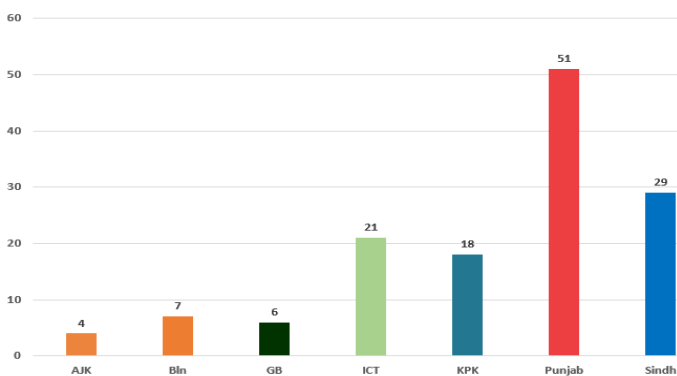

## 1. International

### a. COVID Status

- (1) 67,377,387 COVID cases & 1,541,373 deaths have been reported across the globe.
- (2) Italy's death toll has crossed 60,000 mark.
- (3) Russia has reported 29,039 new cases, its worst daily total since the pandemic began.

### b. Vaccine

- (1) Pfizer Inc has applied for emergency use authorization of its COVID vaccine in India.
- (2) Scotland's first minister has said that they would start administering COVID vaccines from Tuesday.

### c. Lockdown & Restrictions

- (1) Tunisia has extended a night-time curfew until the end of the year.

## 2. National

### a. **Six COVID-19 patients have died due to delayed supply of oxygen to a hospital in Peshawar.**

b. Foreign Officer Spokesperson Zahid Hafeez Chaudhri has said that Russia has offered to provide its COVID-10 vaccine to Pakistan.

c. Federal Minister for Economic Affairs Khusro Bakhtiar has said that despite COVID-19, Pakistan's economic performance remained strong due to prudent policies of the government.

### d. SOP Implementation Measures

- (1) Three restaurants at Karachi's Do Darya have been sealed on the directions of Deputy Commissioner South.
- (2) Inner hall of Faisal Mosque has been sealed by capital's administration after violation of SOPs during Friday's prayers.

### e. COVID Status

- (1) National positivity ratio has reached 9.7 %.
- (2) Pakistan has reported 1530 coronavirus recoveries

### f. Vent Status

- (1) 357 patients have been shifted on ventilator. (536 patients on vents were reported on 22 Jun highest during first wave while.
- (2) **67% vents allocated for COVID patients in Multan have been occupied.**
- (3) 51 % vents allocated for COVID patients in ICT have been occupied.

(4) Vent occupancy in Peshawar has been reported above 40%.

g. **Oxygen Status**

(1) **60% beds allocated for COVID patients in ICT have been occupied.**

(2) 48% beds allocated for COVID patients in Peshawar have been occupied.

(3) 46% beds allocated for COVID patients in Multan have been occupied.

(4) Rawalpindi and Karachi bed occupancy has been reported at 39% and 38% respectively.

h. **HCW (Health Care Workers) Status**

(1) 76 new cases have been reported in HCWs, increasing the total to 10,716 while 9,917 have recovered. (696 active cases)

(2) Most cases in HCWs has been reported by Sindh 3,309.

(3) 103 deaths have been reported amongst HCWs (73 doctors, 1 Medical student, 2 nurses, 27 paramedic staff).

i. **Age wise distribution of COVID cases**

(1) 75.4% of confirmed cases are below 50 years.

(2) 77.3% of deceased cases are above 51 years.

(3) 4,557 death have been reported in age group from 51 - 70 accounting to 54 % of total deaths.

j. **Mortality (58 x Deaths)**

(1) All deaths have occurred in hospitals.

(2) Punjab has reported most death 25 followed by Sindh at 20.

(3) CFR was reported at 2.0 %.

(4) 87% deceased suffered from co-morbidities.
