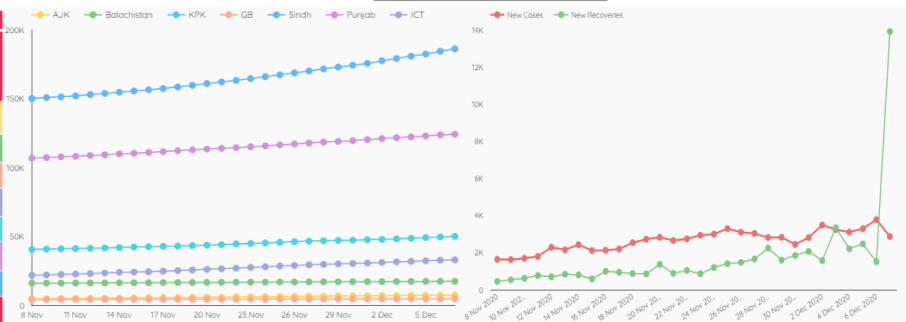

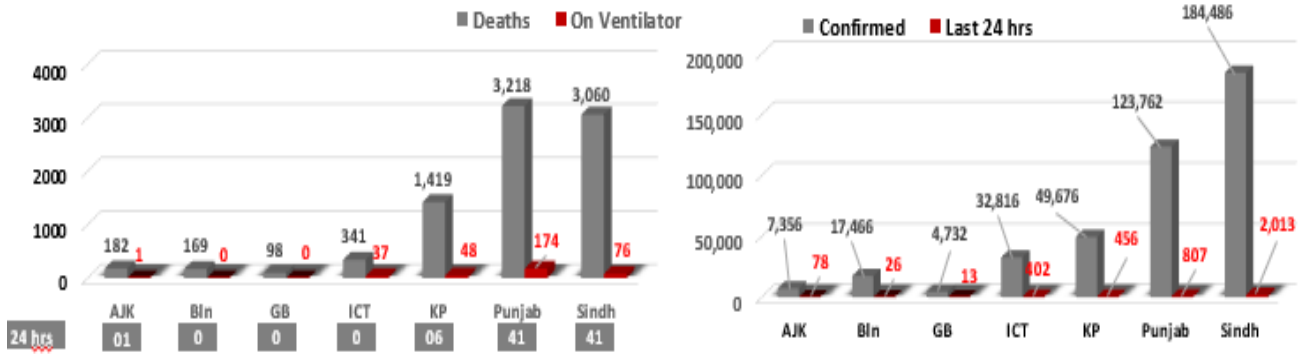

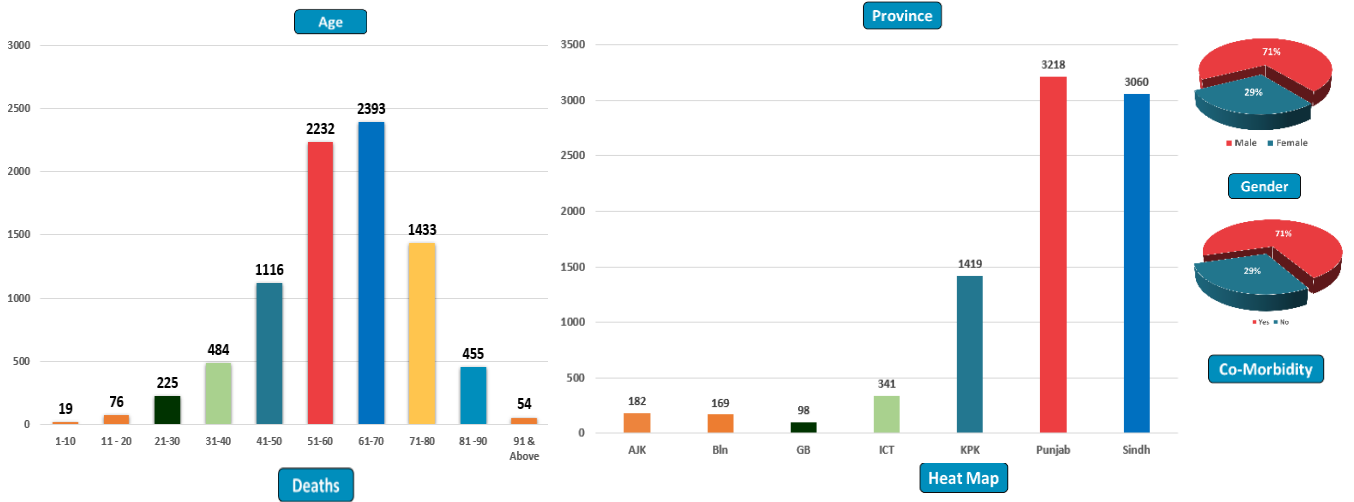
Cases Vs Recovery



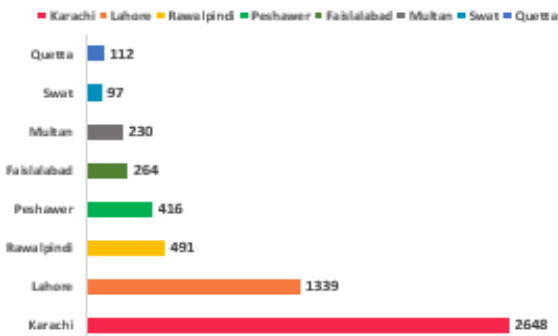
Clinical Status of COVID



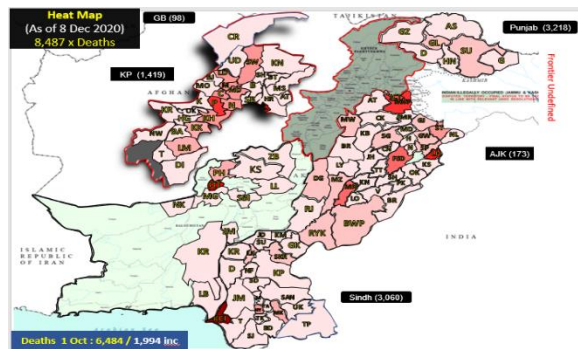
Death Analysis

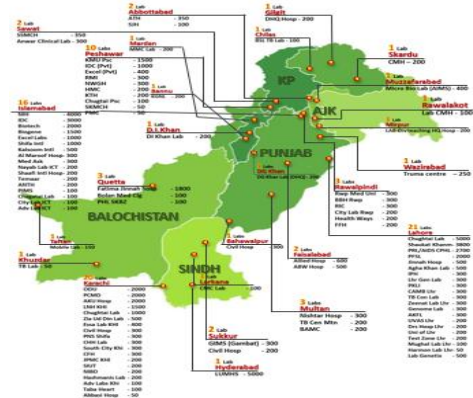
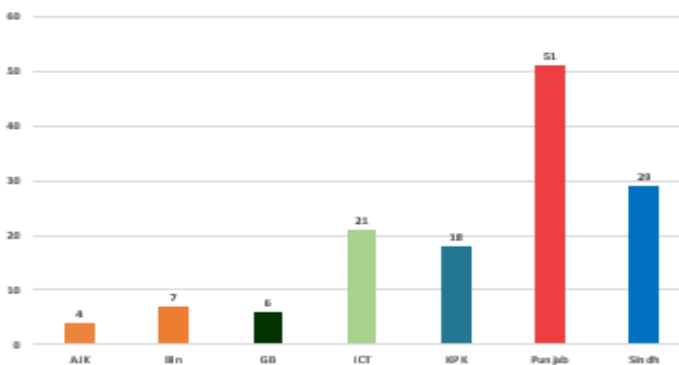


Heat Map

1. International

a. COVID Status

- (1) 67,928,281 COVID cases & 1,549,812 deaths have been reported across the globe.
- (2) Italy reported 528 coronavirus-related deaths in the last 24 hours.

b. Vaccine

- (1) Britain is set to administer the first doses of the Pfizer/BioNTech vaccine on Tuesday.
- (2) China's Sinovac Biotech has secured \$515 million in funding from a local firm to double production capacity of its coronavirus vaccine
- (3) Canadian health ministry has said that it will get up to 249,000 doses of Pfizer Inc's COVID-19 vaccine before the end of December.
- (4) Serum Institute of India has sought emergency use authorisation from India's drug regulator for AstraZeneca Plc's Covid-19 vaccine.
- (5) Brazilian President Jair Bolsonaro said the government will offer COVID-19 vaccines to all Brazilians.

c. Lockdown & Restrictions

- (1) Greece has extended its COVID lockdown measures to 7 January.
- (2) Denmark has decided to close middle & high schools, bars, cafes and restaurants in 38 municipalities this week, affecting almost half of the country's population.
- (3) Lithuania has extended its lockdown until the end of this year.

2. National

a. **23 Sindh police officials test positive for COVID-19.**

- b. Dr Faisal Sultan has said that Health authorities are negotiating with China, Russia and some other countries for procurement of COVID vaccine.

c. COVID Status

- (1) National positivity ratio was recorded at 8.58%.
- (2) Pakistan has reported 13,909 coronavirus recoveries

d. Vent Status

- (1) 353 patients are on ventilators.
- (2) **67% vents allocated for COVID patients in Multan have been occupied.**
- (3) 52 % vents allocated for COVID patients in ICT have been occupied.

(4) Vent occupancy in Peshawar and Lahore has been reported above 38%.

e. **Oxygen Status**

(1) **59% beds allocated for COVID patients in ICT have been occupied.**

(2) 46% beds allocated for COVID patients in Peshawar and Multan have been occupied.

(3) Rawalpindi and Karachi bed occupancy has been reported at 39%.

(4) Abbottabad has reported bed occupancy at 33 %.

f. **HCW (Health Care Workers) Status**

(1) 154 new cases have been reported in HCWs, increasing the total to 10,870 while 9,977 have recovered. (790 active cases)

(2) Most cases in HCWs has been reported by Sindh 3,100.

(3) 103 deaths have been reported amongst HCWs (73 doctors, 1 Medical student, 2 nurses, 27 paramedic staff).

g. **Age wise distribution of COVID cases**

(1) 75.4% of confirmed cases are below 50 years.

(2) 77.3% of deceased cases are above 51 years.

(3) 4,573 death have been reported in age group from 51 - 70 accounting to 54 % of total deaths.

h. **COVID Mortality (37 x Deaths)**

(1) 36 deaths have occurred in hospitals.

(2) Punjab has reported most deaths 15 followed by KP at 9.

(3) CFR was reported at 2.0 %.

(4) 87% deceased suffered from co-morbidities.
