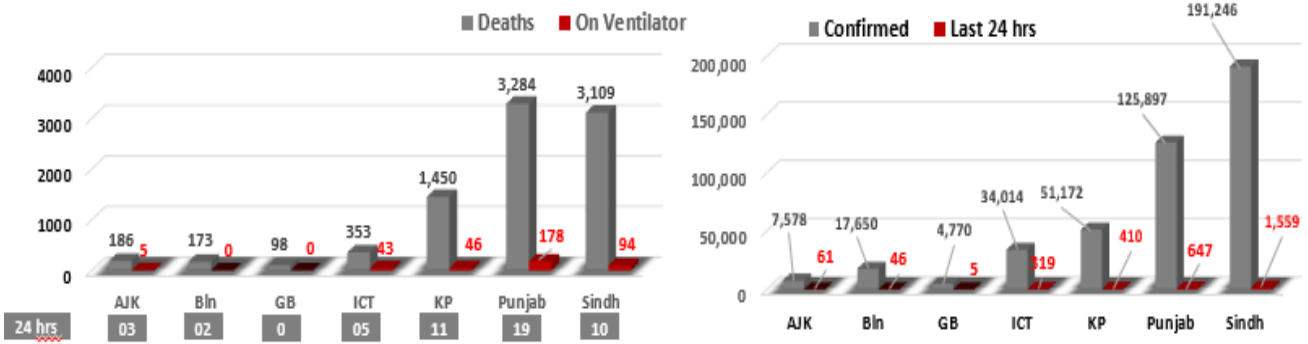

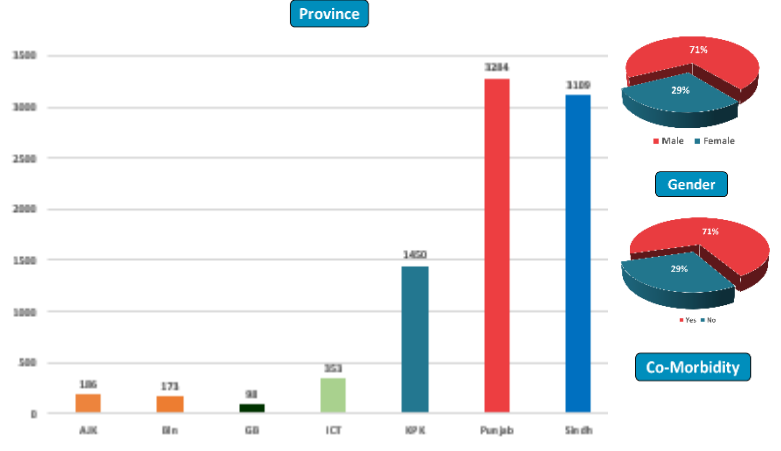
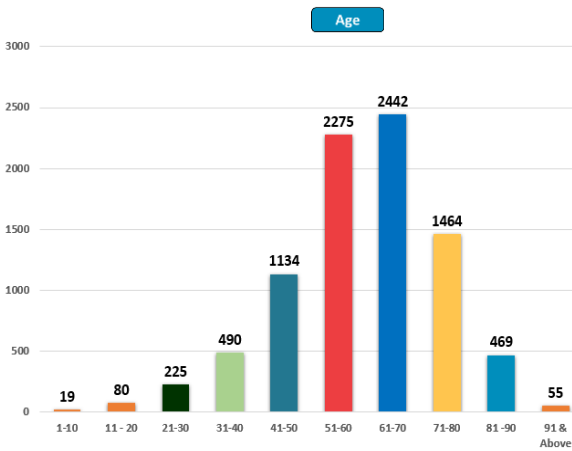
Cases Vs Recovery



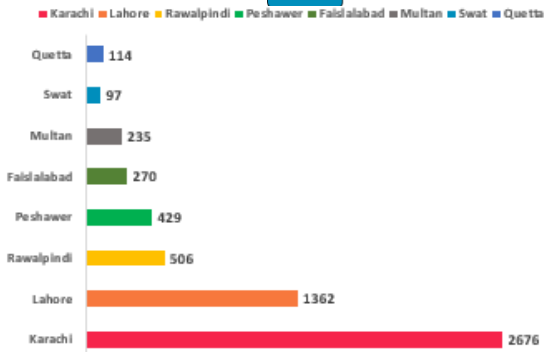
Clinical Status of COVID



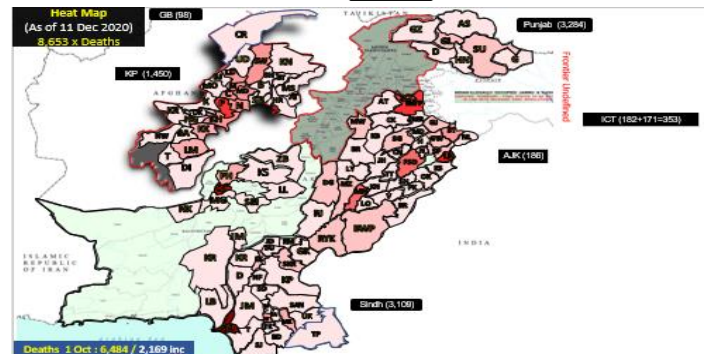
Death Analysis

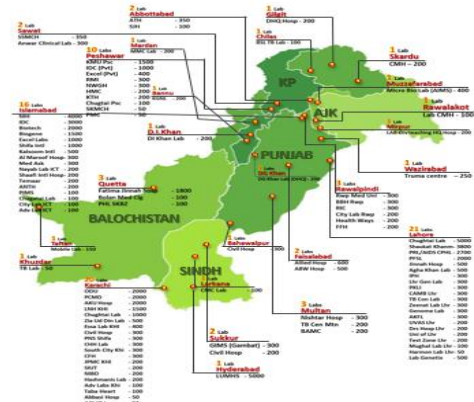
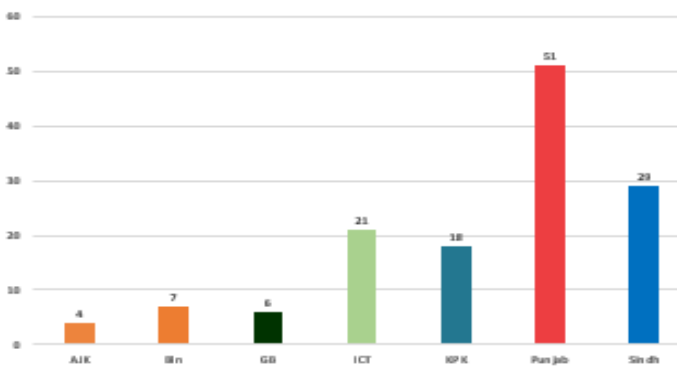


Heat Map

1. International

a. COVID Status

- (1) 70,700,291 COVID cases & 1,587,608 deaths have been reported across the globe.
- (2) Germany has reported its highest one-day total of 23,679 new COVID cases, while the number of deaths linked to COVID-19 has crossed 20,000.
- (3) US records more than 3,000 COVID deaths a day for the first time.
- (4) Italy has reported 887 COVID related deaths in the last 24 hours.

b. Vaccine

- (1) Russia has agreed a deal with Argentina to supply 10m doses of its Sputnik V COVID-19 vaccine.
- (2) Uzbekistan has said that large-scale Phase 3 trials of Anhui Zhifei Longcom Biopharmaceutical Chinese made coronavirus vaccine would begin this week.

c. Lockdown & Restrictions

- (1) France has said that COVID-19 rates still too high to re-open cultural venues.
- (2) **Denmark has decided to expand lockdown measures currently in place to cover almost 80% of its population.**
- (3) Belarus has said it will temporarily close its land border in late December to curb the spread of COVID-19.

d. Research & Developments

- (1) Australian scientists have claimed that they have develop genome sequencing to trace COVID-19 cases within four hours.

2. National

- a. Chief justice of LHC has issued directives to suspend regular court work for next two weeks due to a "rapid increase" COVID cases.
- b. GB CM has said that the COVID-19 transmission rate has reduced to one per cent from seven per cent.
- c. Adviser to the Sindh Chief Minister Syed Aijaz Ali Shah Shirazi has passed away due to COVID complications.
- d. COVID Status
 - (1) National positivity ratio was recorded at 7.15 %.
 - (2) Pakistan has reported 4,791 COVID recoveries

e. **Vent Status**

- (1) 357 patients are on ventilators.
- (2) **64% vents allocated for COVID patients in Multan have been occupied.** (63% day before yesterday)
- (3) 48 % vents allocated for COVID patients in ICT have been occupied. (49% day before yesterday)
- (4) Vent occupancy in Peshawar has been reported at 38%. (41% day before yesterday)

f. **Oxygen Status**

- (1) **61% beds allocated for COVID patients in ICT have been occupied.** (61% day before yesterday)
- (2) **55 % beds allocated for COVID patients in Rawalpindi have been occupied.** (35% day before yesterday)
- (3) 51% beds allocated for COVID patients in Peshawar have been occupied (51% day before yesterday)

g. **HCW (Health Care Workers) Status**

- (1) 60 new cases have been reported in HCWs, increasing the total to 11,069 while 10,142 have recovered. (824 active cases)
- (2) Most cases in HCWs has been reported by Sindh 3,254.
- (3) 103 deaths have been reported amongst HCWs (73 doctors, 1 Medical student, 2 nurses, 27 paramedic staff).

h. **Age wise distribution of COVID cases**

- (1) 75.3% of confirmed cases are below 50 years.
- (2) 77.4% of deceased cases are above 51 years.
- (3) 4,691 death have been reported in age group from 51 - 70 accounting to 55 % of total deaths.

i. **COVID Mortality (56 x Deaths)**

- (1) 51 (91%) deaths have occurred in hospitals.
- (2) 23 deaths have been reported by Punjab, most by any province.
- (3) CFR was reported at 2.0 %.
- (4) 75 % deceased suffered from co-morbidities.
