Clinical Status of COVID

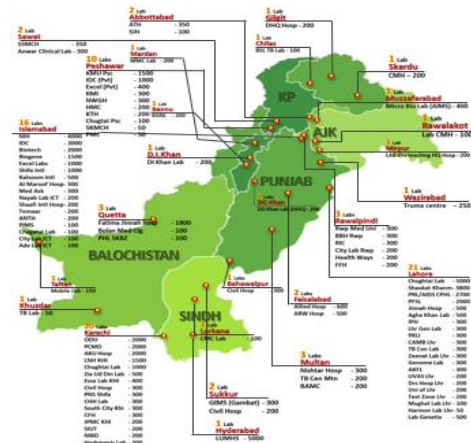
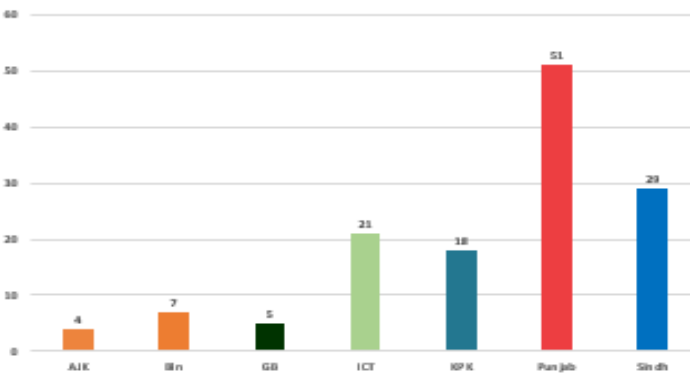


Death Analysis

1. International

a. COVID Status

(1) 71,420,861 COVID cases & 1,600,465 deaths have been reported across the globe.

b. Vaccine

(1) Hungary has said that it will seek domestic approval of a Chinese COVID vaccine rather than waiting for a review by the EU's European Medicines Agency (EMA).

(2) British Drug makers GlaxoSmithKline and Sanofi have said that their COVID-19 vaccine won't be ready until late next year because they need to improve the shot's effectiveness in older people.

(3) U.S. government advisory panel had endorsed widespread use of Pfizer's COVID vaccine.

(4) Australia has halted the production of a home-made vaccine against COVID-19 after trials showed it could interfere with HIV diagnosis.

c. Lockdown & Restrictions

(1) Britain has said that it will reduce self-isolation from 14 to 10 days for travellers arriving from overseas.

2. National

a. ADB said Pakistan's economy is recovering, in manufacturing and construction sectors supported by government's relief package.

b. Punjab government has imposed a lockdown in 50 hotspot areas of Lahore

c. COVID Status

(1) National positivity ratio was recorded at 6.58 %.

(2) Pakistan has reported 2,116 COVID recoveries during last 24 hours.

d. Vent Status

(1) 366 patients are on ventilators.

(2) **67% vents allocated for COVID patients in Multan have been occupied.** (64% day before yesterday).

(3) 51 % vents allocated for COVID patients in ICT have been occupied. (48% day before yesterday).

(4) Vent occupancy in Peshawar has been reported at 40%. (38% day before yesterday).

e. **Oxygen Status**

- (1) **60% beds allocated for COVID patients in ICT & Peshawar have been occupied.** (61% day before yesterday in ICT and 51% in Peshawar)
- (2) **56 % beds allocated for COVID patients in Rawalpindi have been occupied.** (55% day before yesterday)
- (3) 50% beds allocated for COVID patients in Multan have been occupied (48% day before yesterday)

f. **HCW (Health Care Workers) Status**

- (1) 257 new cases have been reported in HCWs, increasing the total to 11,326 while 10,334 have recovered. (883 active cases)
- (2) Most cases in HCWs has been reported by Sindh 3,321.
- (3) 109 deaths have been reported amongst HCWs (76 doctors, 1 Medical student, 2 nurses, 30 paramedic staff).

g. **Age wise distribution of COVID cases**

- (1) 75.3% of confirmed cases are below 50 years.
- (2) 77.5% of deceased cases are above 51 years.
- (3) 4,691 death have been reported in age group from 51 - 70 accounting to 55 % of total deaths.

h. **COVID Mortality (50 x Deaths)**

- (1) 47 (94%) deaths have occurred in hospitals.
- (2) 19 deaths have been reported by Punjab, most by any province.
- (3) CFR was reported at 2.0 %.
- (4) 81 % deceased suffered from co-morbidities.
