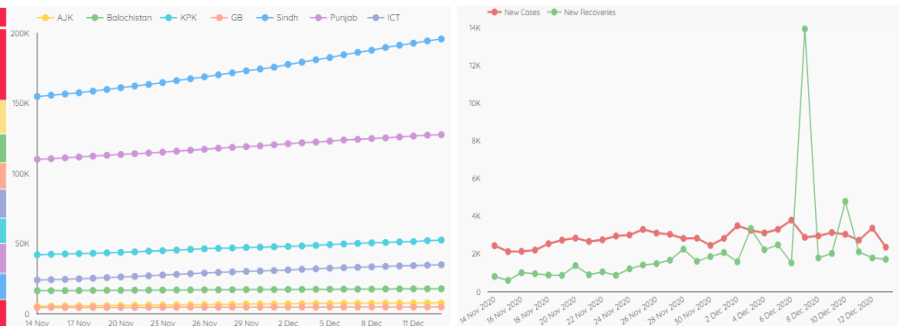

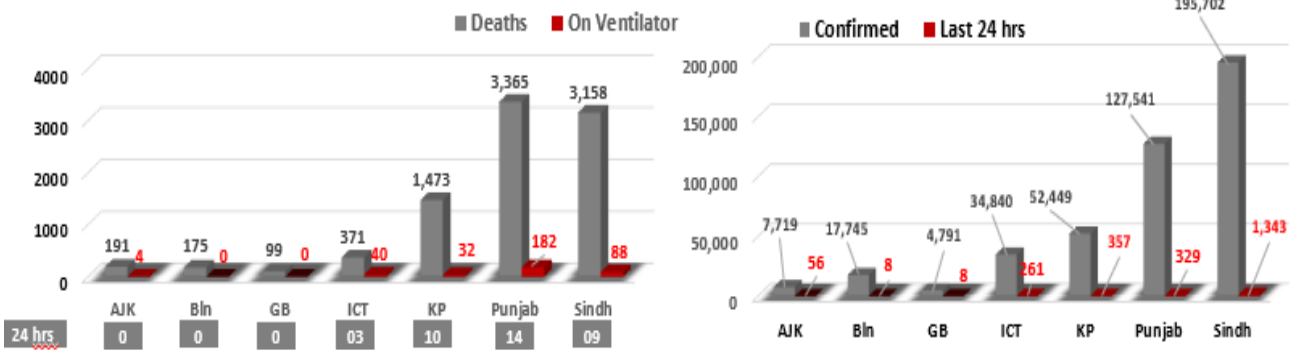

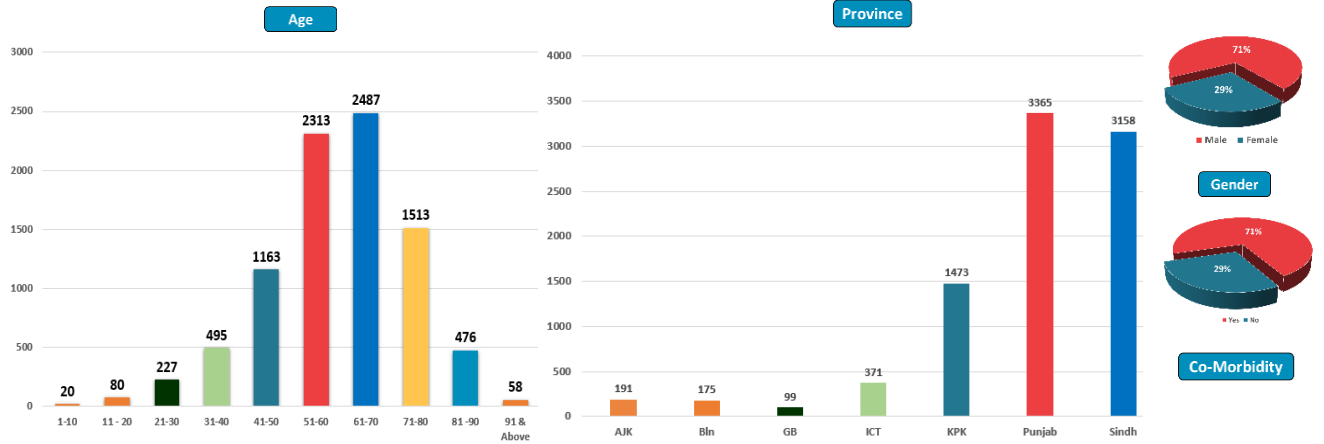
Cases Vs Recovery



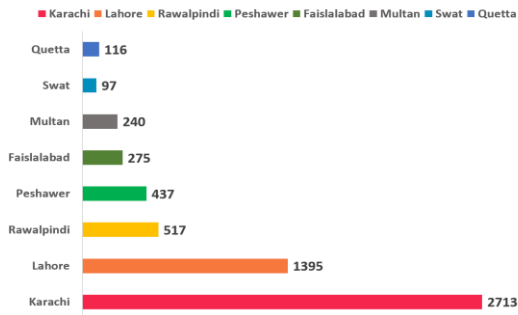
Clinical Status of COVID



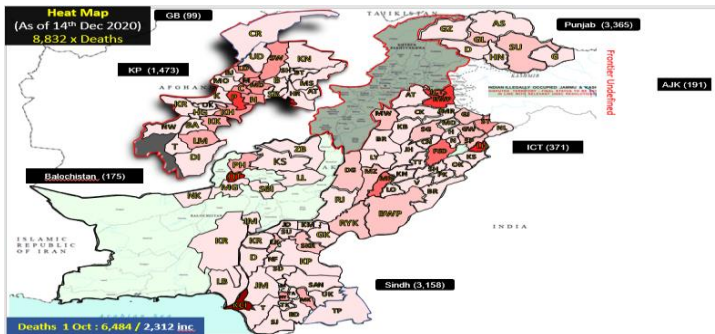
Death Analysis

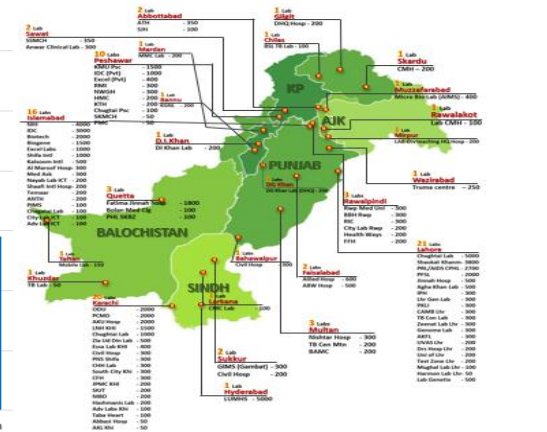
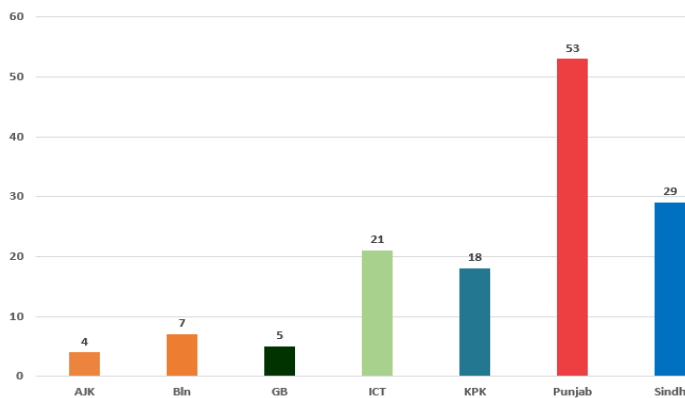


Heat Map

1. International

a. COVID Status

- (1) 72,631,545 COVID cases & 1,618,562 deaths have been reported across the globe.
- (2) Netherlands recorded its highest increase of 10,000 COVID infections since end of October.

b. Vaccine

- (1) Bahrain has said that it approved the use of a Chinese coronavirus vaccine
- (2) Spain health minister has said that it could achieve herd immunity from COVID-19 by the end of summer 2021 if enough people are vaccinated.

c. Lockdown & Restrictions

- (1) Mauritania has reimposed a night-time curfew to curb the spread of COVID.

2. National

- a. Religious scholar Maulana Tariq Jamil has been hospitalised after being diagnosed with COVID-19.

b. COVID Status

- (1) National positivity ratio was recorded at 7.42%.
- (2) Pakistan has reported 1,719 COVID recoveries during last 24 hours.

c. Vent Status

- (1) 353 patients are on ventilators.
- (2) **58% vents allocated for COVID patients in Multan have been occupied.**
(67% day before yesterday)
- (3) 52% vents allocated for COVID patients in ICT have been occupied. (51% day before yesterday)
- (4) Vent occupancy in Lahore has been reported at 37%. (36% day before yesterday)
- (5) Vent occupancy in Peshawar has been reported at 28%. (31% day before yesterday)

d. Oxygen Status

- (1) **63% beds allocated for COVID patients in Peshawar have been occupied** (61% day before yesterday)
- (2) **56% beds allocated for COVID patients in Rawalpindi have been occupied** (56% day before yesterday)

- (3) 50% beds allocated for COVID patients in Multan have been occupied (50% day before yesterday)
- (4) 45% beds allocated for COVID patients in ICT have been occupied. (48% day before yesterday)

e. **HCW (Health Care Workers) Status**

- (1) 61 new cases have been reported in HCWs, increasing the total to 11,451 while 10,451 have recovered. (891 active cases)
- (2) Most cases in HCWs has been reported by Sindh 3,419.
- (3) 109 deaths have been reported amongst HCWs (76 doctors, 1 Medical student, 2 nurses, 30 paramedic staff).

f. **Age wise distribution of COVID cases**

- (1) 75.2% of confirmed cases are below 50 years.
- (2) 77.5% of deceased cases are above 51 years.
- (3) 4,784 death have been reported in age group from 51 - 70 accounting to 54 % of total deaths.

g. **COVID Mortality (72 x Deaths)**

- (1) 67 (93%) deaths have occurred in hospitals.
- (2) 31 deaths have been reported by Punjab, most by any province.
- (3) CFR was reported at 2.13 %.
- (4) 82 % deceased suffered from co-morbidities.
