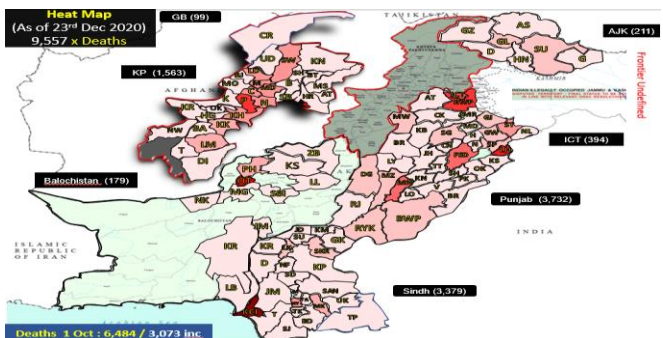
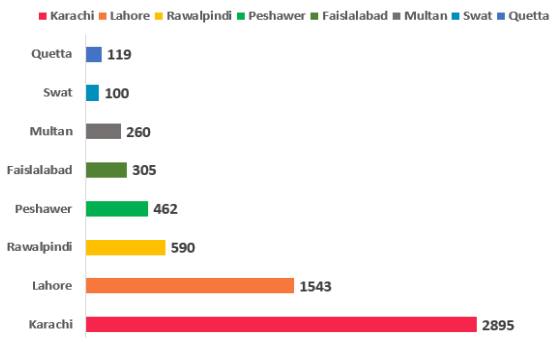
### Clinical Status of COVID

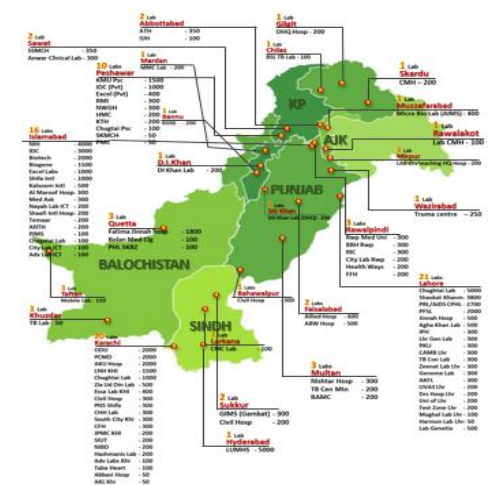
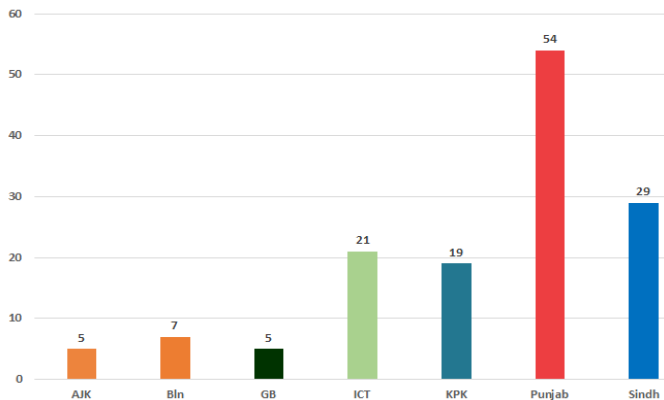

## 1. International

### a. COVID Status

- (1) 78,346,451 COVID cases & 1,722,897 deaths have been reported across the globe.
- (2) India has recorded lowest daily COVID tally of 19,556 cases since 3<sup>rd</sup> July.

### b. Vaccine

- (1) Pfizer Inc and Moderna Inc are testing their COVID-19 vaccines against new fast spreading version of virus that has emerged in Britain.
- (2) Malaysia has signed a deal to procure 6.4 million doses of AstraZeneca's COVID vaccine, and is in final talks with Chinese and Russian manufacturers to secure more.

### c. Lockdown & Restrictions

- (1) Iraq bans air travel with 8 nations (Britain, South Africa, Australia, Denmark, Iran, Japan, Belgium and the Netherlands).

### d. Research / New Developments

- (1) WHO has cautioned against major alarm over a new, highly infectious variant of coronavirus that has emerged in Britain, saying this was a normal part of a pandemic's evolution.

## 2. National

- a. 149 Sindh Police officials test positive for virus in last 5 days.

### b. COVID Status

- (1) National positivity ratio was recorded at 6.01 %.
- (2) Pakistan has reported 4.415 COVID recoveries during last 24 hours.

### c. Vent Status

- (1) 322 patients are on ventilators.
- (2) 52% vents allocated for COVID patients in Multan have been occupied. (46% day before yesterday)
- (3) 39% vents allocated for COVID patients in ICT have been occupied. (44% day before yesterday)
- (4) Vent occupancy in Lahore has been reported at 31%. (31% day before yesterday)

### d. Oxygen Status

- (1) **57% beds allocated for COVID patients in Peshawar have been occupied** (58% day before yesterday)

- (2) 41% beds allocated for COVID patients in Rawalpindi have been occupied. (41% day before yesterday)
- (3) 39% beds allocated for COVID patients in Multan have been occupied (39% day before yesterday)
- (4) 37% beds allocated for COVID patients in Abbottabad have been occupied (39% day before yesterday)
- (5) 36% beds allocated for COVID patients in ICT have been occupied. (37% day before yesterday)
- (6) 32% beds allocated for COVID patients in Karachi have been occupied. (34% day before yesterday)

e. **HCW (Health Care Workers) Status**

- (1) 35 new cases have been reported in HCWs, increasing the total to 12,072 while 11,216 have recovered. (746 active cases)
- (2) Most cases in HCWs has been reported by Sindh 3,889.
- (3) 110 deaths have been reported amongst HCWs (76 doctors, 1 Medical student, 2 nurses, 31 paramedic staff).

f. **Age wise distribution of COVID cases**

- (1) 75% of confirmed cases are below 50 years.
- (2) 77.6% of deceased cases are above 51 years.
- (3) 5,156 deaths have been reported in age group from 51 - 70 accounting to 54 % of total deaths. (44 deaths reported in age group 51 - 70 during last 24 hours)

g. **COVID Mortality (82 x Deaths)**

- (1) 71 (87%) deaths have occurred in hospitals.
- (2) **50 deaths have been reported by Punjab, most by any province.**
- (3) **CFR of Punjab was reported at 8.43 %.**
- (4) National CFR was reported at 4.81 %.
- (5) 83 % deceased suffered from co-morbidities.
