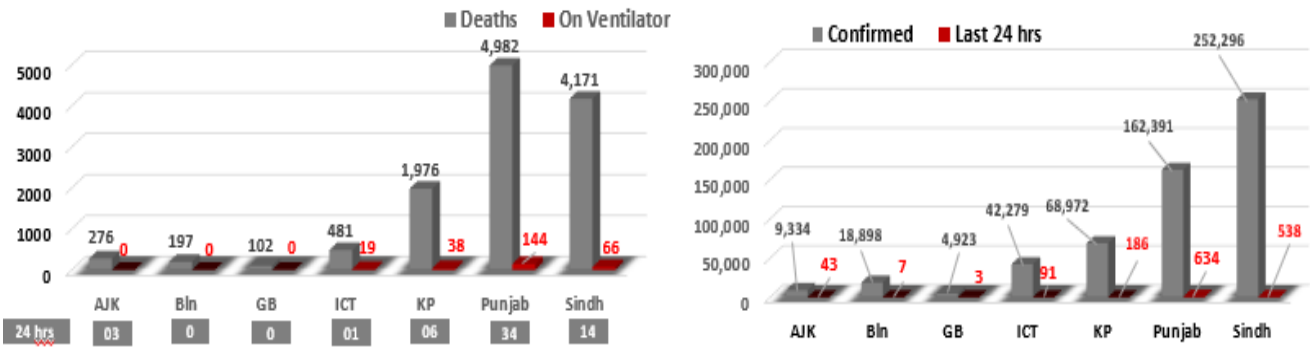

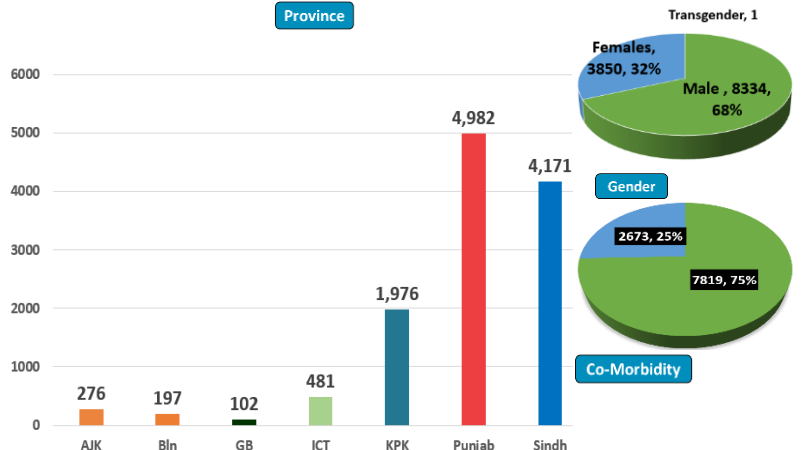
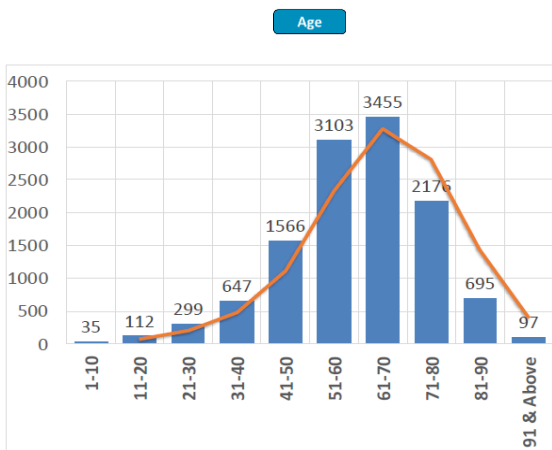
Cases Vs Recovery



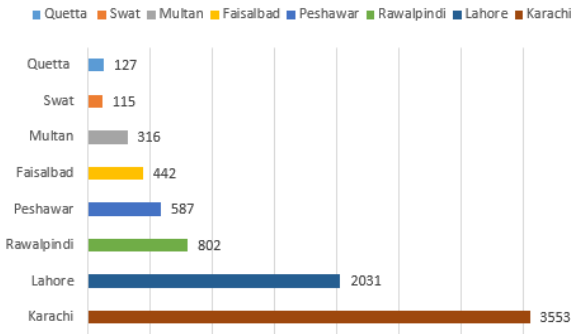
Clinical Status of COVID



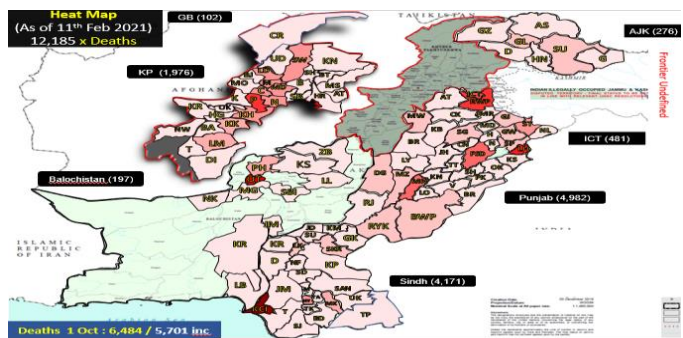
Death Analysis

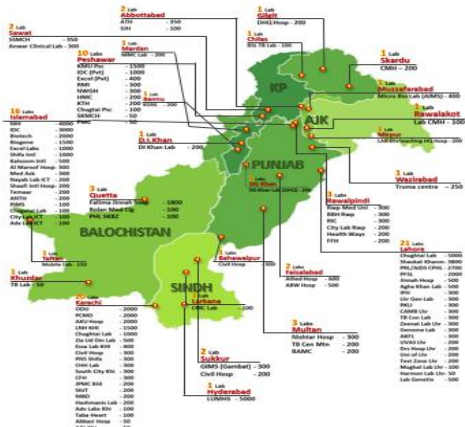
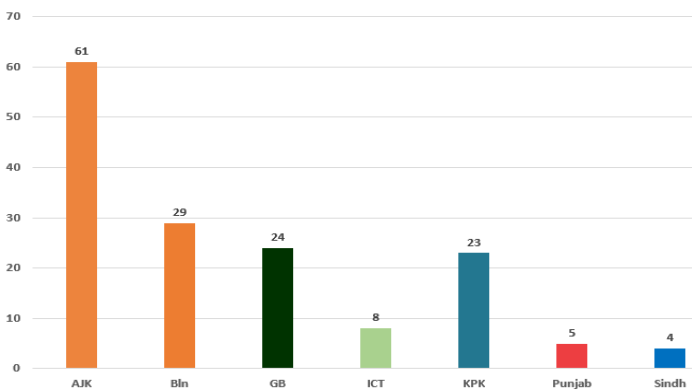


Heat Map

1. International

a. COVID Status

- (1) 107,836,303 COVID cases & 2,363,459 deaths have been reported across the globe.
- (2) California has surpassed New York as the most effected US state with 45,000 COVID deaths.

b. COVID Vaccine

- (1) South Africa is planning to discuss with the international COVAX vaccine scheme whether it can swap 500,000 AstraZeneca vaccine doses it has ordered from the Serum Institute of India.
- (2) WHO expert panel has said that Oxford/AstraZeneca Covid vaccine outweigh any risks and the shot should be recommended for use, including in people aged 65 and older.
- (3) South Africa is planning to immunise between 350,000 and 500,000 health workers with Johnson & Johnson's COVID vaccine.
- (4) Bahrain has authorised Russia's Sputnik V Covid-19 vaccine for emergency use.
- (5) Johnson & Johnson chief executive Alex Gorsky has said that people might need to get vaccinated against Covid-19 annually for the next several years.
- (6) New Zealand has approved Pfizer and BioNTech vaccine.

c. COVID Treatment

- (1) Eli Lilly's antibody therapy to fight Covid-19 has been granted EUA by US FDA.

2. National

a. COVID Status

- (1) National positivity ratio was recorded at 4.01 %.
- (2) Pakistan has reported 1,732 COVID recoveries during last 24 hours.

b. Vent Status

- (1) 256 patients are on ventilators.
- (2) 37% vents allocated for COVID patients in Multan have been occupied. (35% day before yesterday)
- (3) Vent occupancy in Lahore has been reported at 33%. (33% day before yesterday)

- (4) 26% vents allocated for COVID patients in ICT have been occupied. (27% day before yesterday)

c. **Oxygen Status**

- (1) **42% beds allocated for COVID patients in Peshawar have been occupied** (41% day before yesterday)
- (2) 23% beds allocated for COVID patients in Multan have been occupied (32% day before yesterday)
- (3) 23% beds allocated for COVID patients in Rawalpindi have been occupied. (25% day before yesterday)

d. **HCW (Health Care Workers) Status**

- (1) 26 new cases have been reported in HCWs, increasing the total to 13,973 while 13,198 have recovered (641 active cases)
- (2) Most cases in HCWs have been reported by Sindh 5,272
- (3) 134 deaths have been reported amongst HCWs.

e. **COVID Mortality (62 x Deaths)**

- (1) 54 (87%) deaths have occurred in hospitals.
- (2) **29 deaths have been reported by Punjab.**
- (3) **14 deaths have been reported in District Karachi. Most by any district**
- (4) National CFR was reported at 5.78 %.
- (5) 91 % deceased suffered from co-morbidities.
