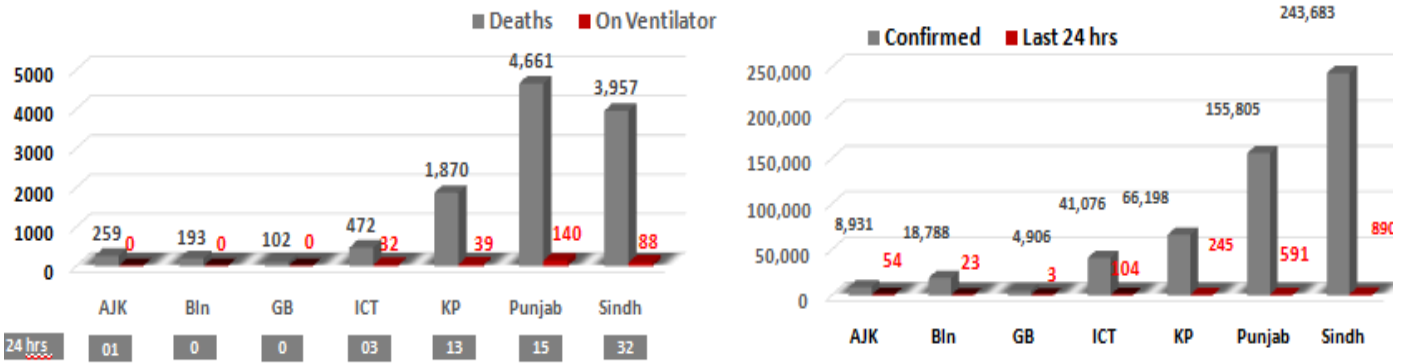

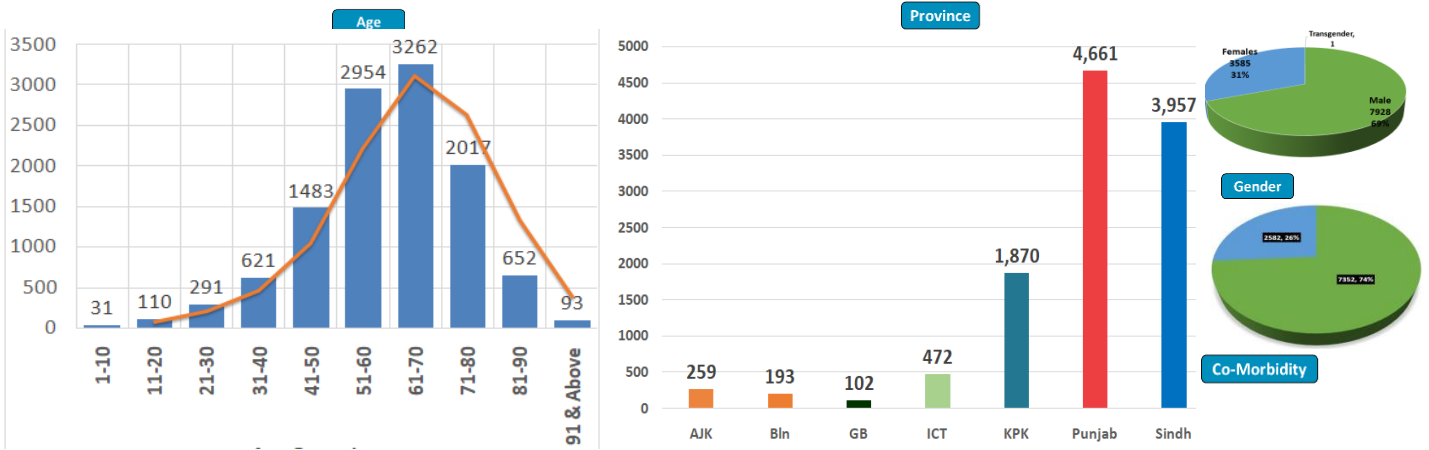
Cases Vs Recovery



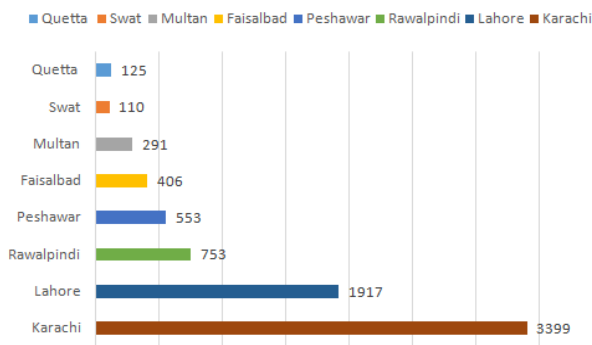
Clinical Status of COVID



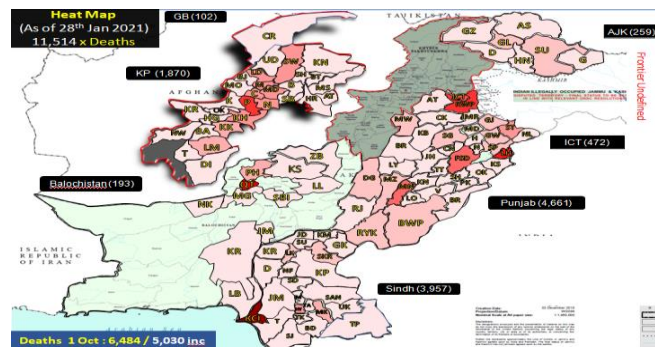
Death Analysis

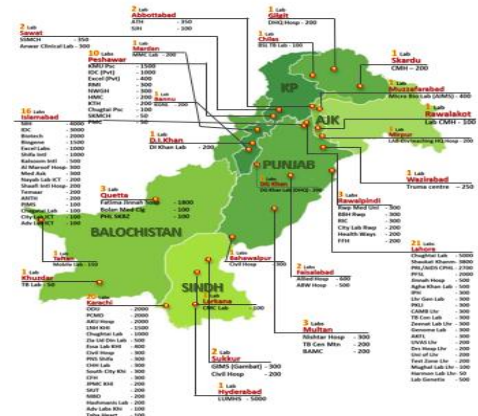
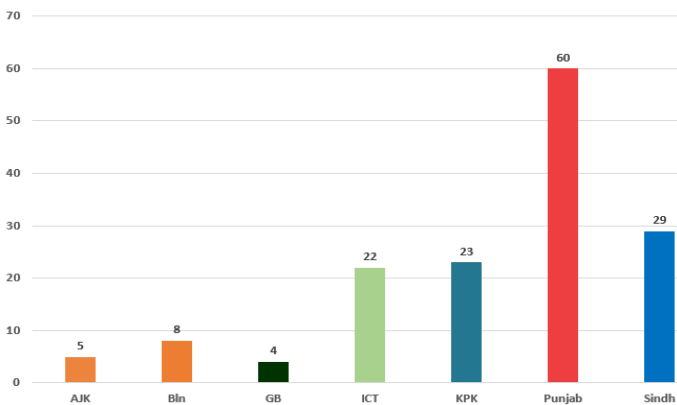


Heat Map

1. International

a. COVID Status

- (1) 101,412,150 COVID cases & 2,182,433 deaths have been reported across the globe.
- (2) Global COVID cases have surpassed 100 Mn mark.
- (3) Death toll in Britain from COVID pandemic crossed 100,000 mark.

b. Vaccine

- (1) South Africa has approved Oxford/AstraZeneca COVID-19 vaccine for emergency use.
- (2) Uludağ University Medical Microbiology department Turkey has claimed that it has prepared a nasal spray Genoxyn that can eliminate COVID from mouth and nose within a minute.

c. COVID Treatment

- (1) US company Eli Lilly's has claimed that their synthetic antibodies treatment against COVID-19 reduced hospitalisations and deaths by 70 % in high-risk patients.

2. National

a. COVID Status

- (1) National positivity ratio was recorded at 4.67 %.
- (2) Pakistan has reported 2,371 COVID recoveries during last 24 hours.

b. Vent Status

- (1) 299 patients are on ventilators.
- (2) 36% vents allocated for COVID patients in ICT have been occupied. (37% day before yesterday)
- (3) Vent occupancy in Lahore has been reported at 35%. (37% day before yesterday)
- (4) 32% vents allocated for COVID patients in Multan have been occupied. (38% day before yesterday)
- (5) 29% vents allocated for COVID patients in Peshawar have been occupied. (32% day before yesterday)
- (6) 27% vents allocated for COVID patients in Bahawalpur have been occupied. (32% day before yesterday)

c. Oxygen Status

- (1) **44% beds allocated for COVID patients in Peshawar have been occupied** (45% day before yesterday)

- (2) 36% beds allocated for COVID patients in Karachi have been occupied.
(37% day before yesterday)
- (3) 33% beds allocated for COVID patients in Multan have been occupied
(28% day before yesterday)

d. **HCW (Health Care Workers) Status**

- (1) 20 new cases have been reported in HCWs, increasing the total to 13,675 while 12,879 have recovered (682 active cases)
- (2) Most cases in HCWs have been reported by Sindh 5,075
- (3) 132 deaths have been reported amongst HCWs.

e. **COVID Mortality (74 x Deaths)**

- (1) 63 (85%) deaths have occurred in hospitals.
- (2) **38 deaths have been reported by Punjab.**
- (3) **21 deaths have been reported in District Karachi. Most by any district**
- (4) National CFR was reported at 4.73 %.
- (5) 81% deceased suffered from co-morbidities.
