## 1. International

### a. COVID Status

- (1) 118,146,596 COVID cases & 2,621,162 deaths have been reported across the globe.
- (2) Brazil has recorded record number of deaths 2,286 during last 24 hours.
- (3) Turkey has reported record number of 14,556 COVID cases over the past 24 hours.
- (4) France has reported 30,303 new coronavirus infections over the past 24 hours (rising above 30,000 for the first time in two weeks).
- (5) Poland has reported 17,260 highest COVID rates since November.
- (6) Bulgaria has reported 3,502 new COVID cases, its highest daily tally in three months

### b. COVID Vaccine

- (1) Four other countries Estonia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Latvia have suspended use of AstraZeneca vaccine after four patients were diagnosed with dangerous blood clotting conditions in Austria.
- (2) Morocco and Kenya have approved Russia's Sputnik V vaccine.

### c. Study & Research

- (1) Mortality Study in Exeter University UK has concluded that British variant B.1.1.7 of COVID-19 is 30% - 100% more deadly and 40%-70% more transmissible.

## 2. National

### a. COVID Status

- (1) National positivity ratio was recorded at 5.35 %.
- (2) Pakistan has reported 1,277 COVID recoveries during last 24 hours

### b. Vent Status

- (1) 227 patients are on ventilators.
- (2) Vent occupancy in Lahore has been reported at 37%. (40% day before yesterday)
- (3) 37% vents allocated for COVID patients in ICT have been occupied. (32% day before yesterday)
- (4) 24% vents allocated for COVID patients in Peshawar have been occupied. (22% day before yesterday)

c. **Oxygen Status**

- (1) **94% beds allocated for COVID patients in Gujrat have been occupied.** (94% day before yesterday)
- (2) **41% beds allocated for COVID patients in Peshawar have been occupied** (38% day before yesterday)
- (3) 33% beds allocated for COVID patients in ICT have been occupied (32% day before yesterday)
- (4) 27% beds allocated for COVID patients in Lahore have been occupied (27% day before yesterday)
- (5) 25% beds allocated for COVID patients in Multan have been occupied (29% day before yesterday)

d. **HCW (Health Care Workers) Status**

- (1) **9** new cases have been reported in HCWs, increasing the total to **14,504** while **13,898** have recovered (467 active cases)
- (2) Most cases in HCWs have been reported by Sindh **5,461**
- (3) 139 deaths have been reported amongst HCWs. (88 doctors, Medical Student, 3 nurses, 47 paramedic staff)

e. **COVID Mortality (43 x Deaths)**

- (1) 40 (93%) deaths have occurred in hospitals.
- (2) **29 deaths have been reported by Punjab.**
- (3) **16 deaths have been reported in District Lahore. Most by any district**
- (4) National CFR was reported at **2.40 %**.
- (5) 79 % deceased suffered from co-morbidities.
