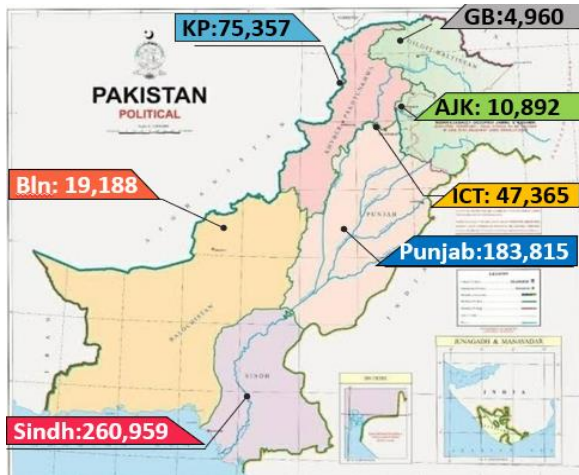

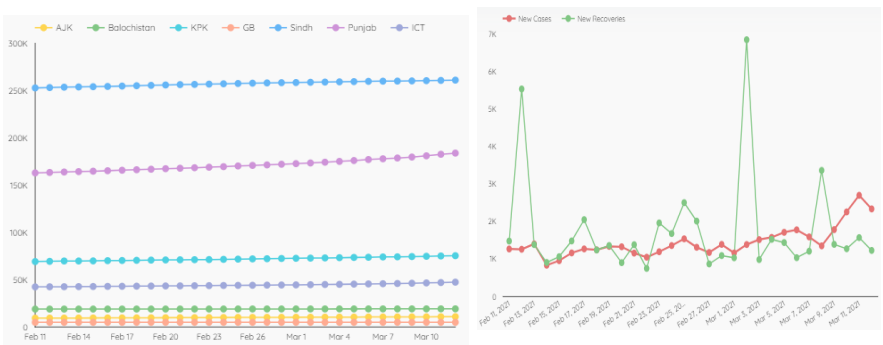

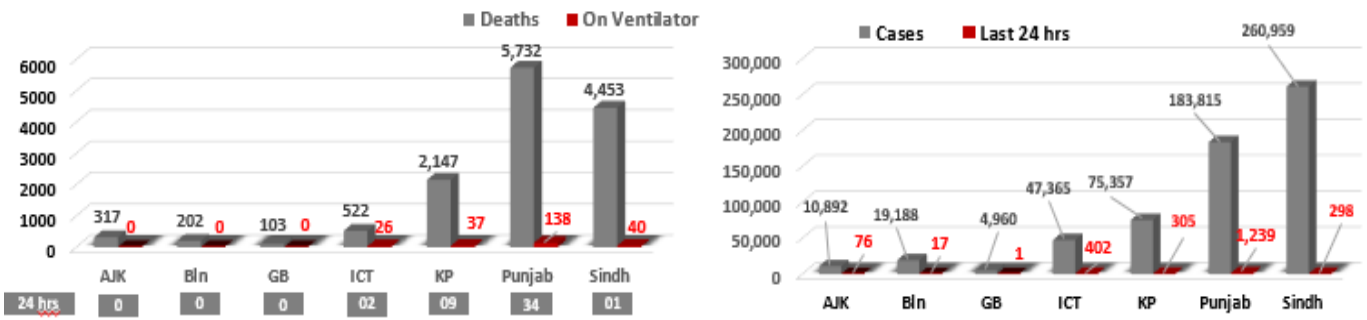

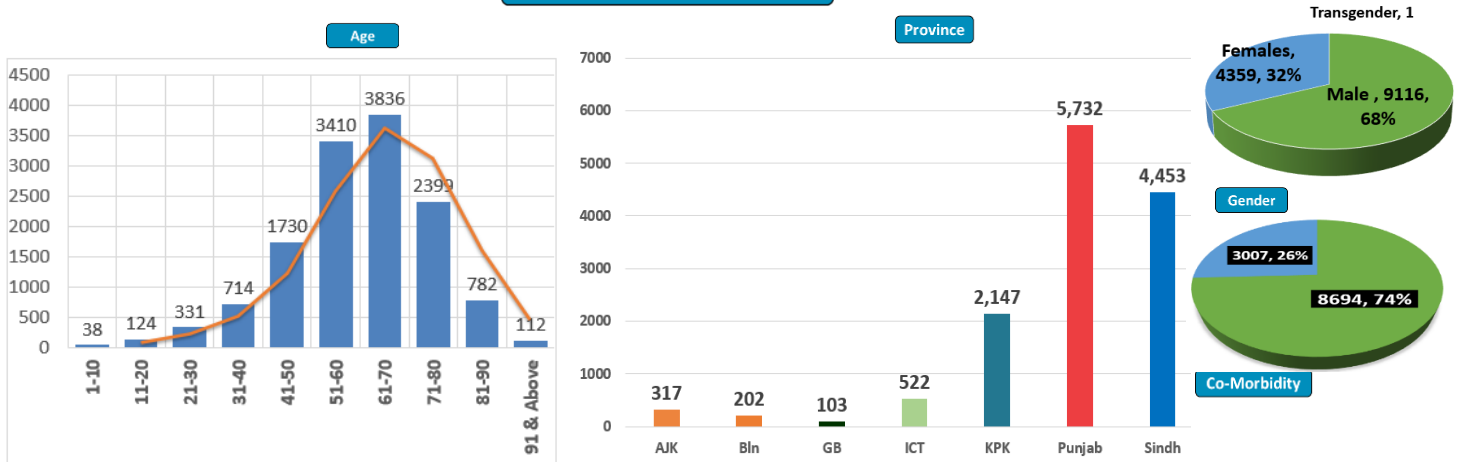
Cases Vs Recovery



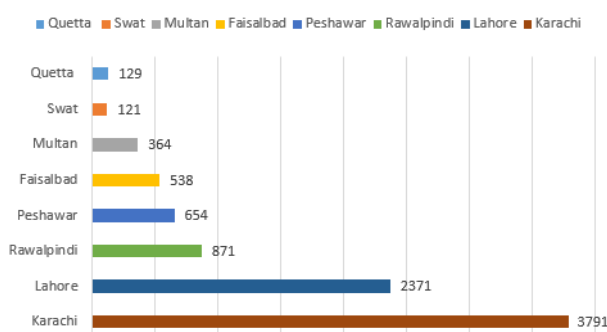
Clinical Status of COVID



Death Analysis

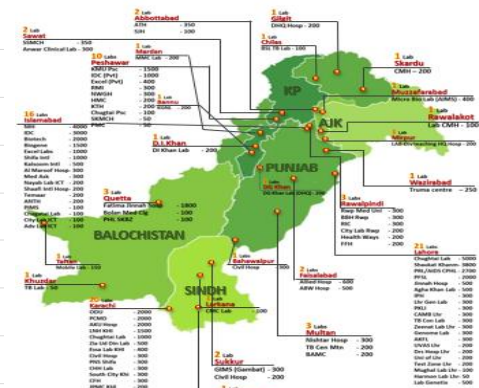
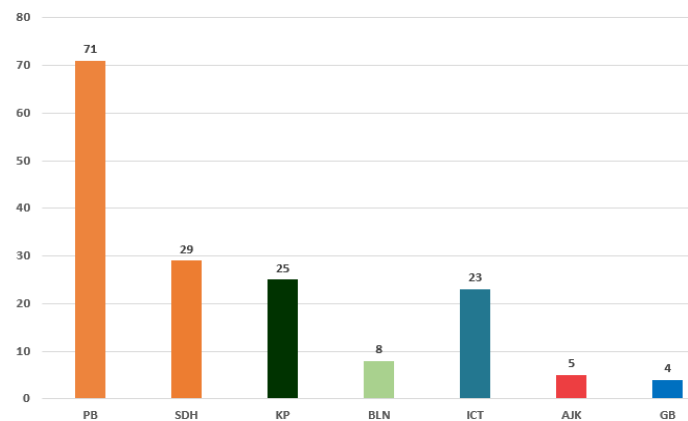


Deaths

1. International

a. COVID Status

(1) 119,597,209 COVID cases & 2,650,899 deaths have been reported across the globe.

b. COVID Vaccine

(1) WHO has said there was no reason to stop using AstraZeneca's Covid-19 vaccine.

(2) Novavax COVID-19 vaccine was 96% effective in preventing cases caused by the original version of the coronavirus in a late stage trial conducted in UK.

(3) Canada has said AstraZeneca COVID-19 vaccine is safe after Denmark and Norway temporarily suspended its use

c. Lockdown & Restrictions

(1) Kenya extends nationwide Covid-19 curfew for two months.

(2) Italy has decided to impose nationwide coronavirus lockdown over Easter weekend.

2. National

a. COVID Status

(1) National positivity ratio was recorded at 5.50%.

(2) Pakistan has reported 1,231 COVID recoveries during last 24 hours

b. Vent Status

(1) 41 patients are on ventilators.

(2) Vent occupancy in Lahore has been reported at 39%. (39% day before yesterday)

(3) 33% vents allocated for COVID patients in ICT have been occupied. (37% day before yesterday)

(4) 22% vents allocated for COVID patients in Peshawar have been occupied. (24% day before yesterday)

c. Oxygen Status

(1) **94% beds allocated for COVID patients in Gujrat have been occupied.** (94% day before yesterday)

(2) **40% beds allocated for COVID patients in Peshawar have been occupied** (39% day before yesterday)

(3) 37% beds allocated for COVID patients in ICT have been occupied (36% day before yesterday)

- (4) 29% beds allocated for COVID patients in Lahore have been occupied (29% day before yesterday)
- (5) 25% beds allocated for COVID patients in Multan have been occupied (25% day before yesterday)

d. **HCW (Health Care Workers) Status**

- (1) 13 new cases have been reported in HCWs, increasing the total to **14,525** while **13,917** have recovered (465 active cases)
- (2) Most cases in HCWs have been reported by Sindh **5,466**
- (3) 143 deaths have been reported amongst HCWs. (92 doctors, Medical Student, 3 nurses, 47 paramedic staff)

e. **COVID Mortality (54 x Deaths)**

- (1) 51 (94%) deaths have occurred in hospitals.
- (2) **36 deaths have been reported by Punjab.**
- (3) **19 deaths have been reported in District Lahore. Most by any district**
- (4) National CFR was reported at **1.99 %**.
- (5) 65 % deceased suffered from co-morbidities.
