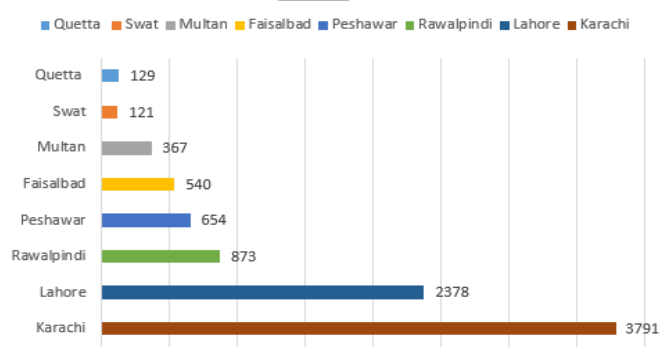
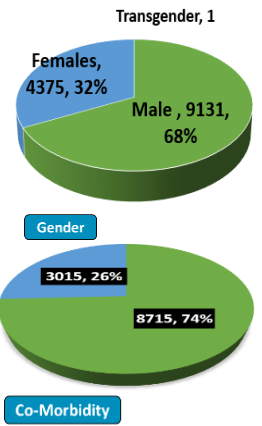
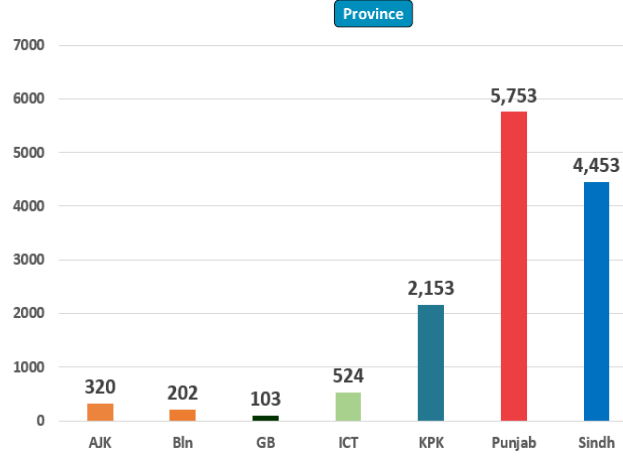
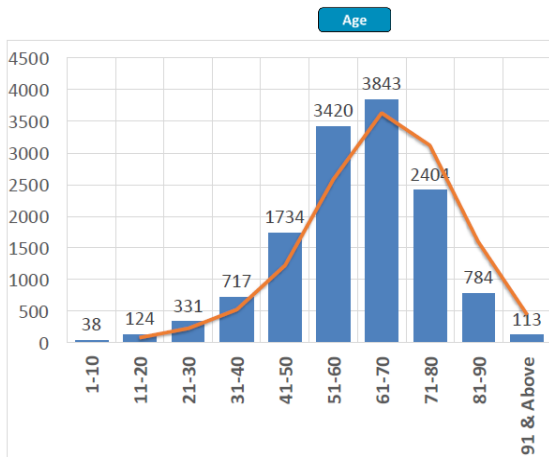
## Cases Vs Recovery



### Clinical Status of COVID

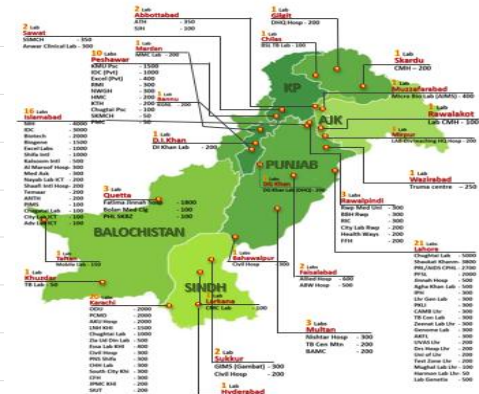
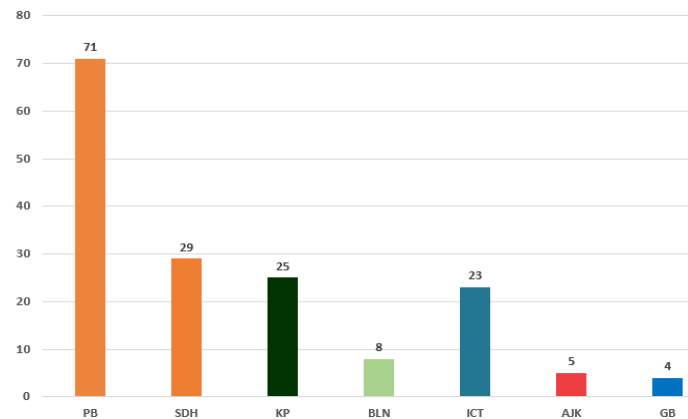

## 1. International

### a. COVID Status

- (1) 120,041,601 COVID cases & 2,659,177 deaths have been reported across the globe.
- (2) India has reported its highest daily spike of the year with 24,882 COVID-19 cases reported in the last 24 hours.

### b. COVID Vaccine

- (1) India has decided to review AstraZeneca side effects after concerns in Europe.
- (2) France's health regulator has approved Johnson & Johnson's single-dose COVID-19 vaccine

## 2. National

### a. COVID Status

- (1) National positivity ratio was recorded at 6.56 %.
- (2) Pakistan has reported 1,275 COVID recoveries during last 24 hours

### b. Vent Status

- (1) 247 patients are on ventilators.
- (2) Vent occupancy in Lahore has been reported at 38%. (39% day before yesterday)
- (3) 32% vents allocated for COVID patients in ICT have been occupied. (33% day before yesterday)
- (4) 26% vents allocated for COVID patients in Peshawar have been occupied. (22% day before yesterday)

### c. Oxygen Status

- (1) **100% beds allocated for COVID patients in Gujrat have been occupied.** (94% day before yesterday)
- (2) **42% beds allocated for COVID patients in Peshawar have been occupied** (40% day before yesterday)
- (3) 35% beds allocated for COVID patients in ICT have been occupied (37% day before yesterday)
- (4) 29% beds allocated for COVID patients in Lahore have been occupied (29% day before yesterday)
- (5) 25% beds allocated for COVID patients in Multan have been occupied (25% day before yesterday)

- (6) 25% beds allocated for COVID patients in Rawalpindi have been occupied

d. **HCW (Health Care Workers) Status**

- (1) 11 new cases have been reported in HCWs, increasing the total to **14,536** while **13,922** have recovered (471 active cases)
- (2) Most cases in HCWs have been reported by Sindh **5,471**
- (3) 143 deaths have been reported amongst HCWs. (92 doctors, Medical Student, 3 nurses, 47 paramedic staff)

e. **COVID Mortality (46 x Deaths)**

- (1) 45 (98%) deaths have occurred in hospitals.
- (2) **34 deaths have been reported by Punjab.**
- (3) **12 deaths have been reported in District Lahore. Most by any district**
- (4) National CFR was reported at **1.96 %**.
- (5) 86% deceased suffered from co-morbidities.
