


Cases Vs Recovery




Clinical Status of COVID




Death Analysis





Heat Map

1. International

- a. Iran's daily tally of coronavirus deaths hit a **record high of 434**.
- b. South Korea has said it will **expand its mandatory mask policy** to spas, wedding halls and other places as part of new social distancing rules aimed at preparing for a prolonged Covid-19 outbreak.
- c. **Russia's daily tally of coronavirus cases hit a record high of 18,665**, including 5,261 in Moscow, taking the national tally to 1,636,781.
- d. **UK records 23,254 new COVID-19 cases**.
- e. Iran has announced that it will **restrict travel to cities hit hardest by the novel coronavirus**.
- f. Britain starts **accelerated review for AstraZeneca's** potential COVID-19 vaccine.
- g. Protesters in **several Spanish cities have clashed** with security forces for a second night, due to anger over coronavirus restrictions.
- h. Half of **Slovakia's population tested** for coronavirus in 2-day nationwide testing drive.
- i. **India's coronavirus caseload stands at 8.1 million**, with 48,268 new cases being recorded in the last 24 hours.
- j. Russia's new coronavirus cases hit **record high of 18,665**.
- k. Europe's new COVID-19 cases have **doubled in five weeks**, while increasing the region tally across 10 million total infections.
- l. Australia **records no new COVID-19 cases** for first time in 5 months.
- m. Portugal **reimposes partial lockdown** in most of the country.
- n. Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan's **spokesman and interior minister** have both announced that they have tested positive for the coronavirus.
- o. PM Boris Johnson has ordered England back into a **national lockdown** after UK crossed one million COVID-19 cases.
- p. Saudi Arabia has **allowed international pilgrims to perform Umrah** after a seven-month due to coronavirus outbreak.

2. National

- a. COVID-19 vaccine trial gets **positive public response** in Karachi.
- b. Balochistan CM Jam Kamal Khan **tested negative for COVID-19**, 20 days after contracting the virus.
- c. Federal government has **decided to make it mandatory** for airlines to verify the medical test reports of passengers travelling to other countries.
