
Province-Wise COVID Cases







Death Analysis

1. International

- a. Europe's coronavirus infections **cross 11 million**.
- b. Norway has decided that it will announce **further restrictions** this week to slow the spread of the coronavirus.
- c. Bahrain has granted **emergency approval** for the use of a Covid-19 vaccine Sinopharm's on frontline workers.
- d. Health minister Maksym Stepanov said that **Ukraine is close to coronavirus catastrophe**.
- e. Sri Lanka has **postponed school reopening** amid virus surge.
- f. Spain sets record Covid-19 case rise with over 55,000 new infections.
- g. Number of new Covid-19 cases in the US hit **another record high last week**, rising 18% to more than 575,000, while deaths inched up 3%.
- h. France's reported a record 52,518 new COVID-19 and number of **people hospitalised with the disease rose by more than 1,000** for the fourth time in eight days.

2. National

- a. National Assembly Secretariat and the Senate Secretariat has directed to **close down their respective offices** for the next three days amid rising coronavirus cases.
- b. Prime Minister Imran Khan has said that **Business and industries will not be closed**.
- c. KP government has decided to **restrict the entry to its offices** across the province to stem the spread of novel.
- d. Pakistan Institute of Medical Sciences (PIMS) has **postponed all elective surgeries** due to the rise in Covid-19 cases in the capital.
- e. Minister for Planning, Development and Special Initiatives Asad Umer has said that the **government would continue its smart lockdown policy** during second wave of the Covid-19.
- f. Pakistan and ADB signed **\$2 million grant agreement** to strengthen the country's efforts to combat the coronavirus pandemic.
