


Cases Vs Recovery



Clinical Status of COVID





Death Analysis

1. International

- a. Pfizer (US) has claimed that its **experimental vaccine was more than 90 % effective** in preventing COVID-19.
- b. WHO chief has called on everyone to keep fighting COVID-19, warning that while **we may be sick of battling the pandemic, the virus is “not tired of us”**.
- c. **New COVID cases registered in the Netherlands have fallen sharply**, continuing a decline that began in early November after entering a second near-lockdown on October 13.
- d. WHO chief has said that it was looking forward to **working closely with the administration of US President-elect Joe Biden**.
- e. India has reported **45,903 new coronavirus cases, with its capital recording 7,745 cases highest single-day rise** in infections since pandemic began.
- f. A senior WHO official has said that a **COVID-19 vaccine may be rolled out by March 2021**, which along with other advances could fundamentally change the course of the pandemic.
- g. Tata Medical and Diagnostics, healthcare unit of India's Tata Group, **has launched its COVID-19 test kit** which will be made available at laboratories and hospitals from December.
- h. US has become first nation worldwide since the pandemic began to **surpass 10 million coronavirus infection**.
- i. Israel has said it would **test people arriving from Denmark for a new mutated strain of coronavirus** stemming from Danish mink farms.
- j. **Italy** has registered **25,271 new coronavirus infections** over the past 24 hours.
- k. **Ukrainian** President, Volodymyr Zelenskiy, has **tested positive for coronavirus**, the presidential office has said.
- l. **Russia** has reported a **record high of 21,798 new coronavirus infections**.
- m. **Iran** has reported a daily **increase of 10,463 coronavirus cases** in the past 24 hours.
- n. **German** health minister, has cautioned that the **country's health system will no longer be able to cope if COVID infection rate** continues to rise.
- o. **Pandemics expert in UK have said that half of positive cases in UK are not being identified**.

2. National

- a. PPP leader and former information minister, **Qamar Zaman Kaira, has tested positive for coronavirus**.

- b. Four COVID-19 patients, admitted to Hyderabad's Liaquat University Hospital (LUH) have **lost their lives due to COVID**.
