







Clinical Status of COVID




Death Analysis



Deaths





Heat Map

1. International

- a. Austria has **planned “mass testing”** for COVID to chart a way out of second lockdown coming into force next week.
- b. French police **stepped up checks in Paris** to ensure residents were complying with lockdown rules imposed to curb the spread of Covid-19.
- c. Malaysia reports **1,208 new coronavirus cases** with 3 new deaths.
- d. Indonesia **reports 4,106 new coronavirus** cases, 63 new deaths.
- e. Iranian president, Hassan Rouhani, declared **“the general mobilisation of the nation and the government”** after health authorities announced the highest ever number of daily cases in the country.
- f. Iran reports **record daily** coronavirus cases of 12,543.
- g. France sees **drop in COVID-19 hospitalisations** for the first time since September.
- h. Germany Economy Minister has **predicted four to five more months** of COVID restrictions.
- i. Dr. Fauci says success of **Pfizer’s COVID vaccine trial** may help persuade more people to get inoculated.
- j. Czech Republic has reported a **further decline in the number of Covid-19 infections** and deaths from daily highs seen in early November, but the country remains among the hardest hit in Europe during this second wave of the pandemic.
- k. India has reported **41,100 new cases of coronavirus** in the past 24 hours, taking the country’s overall tally since the pandemic began to 8.79 million.
- l. Russia reported a daily increase of **22,572 COVID infections**, taking the national tally to 1,925,825.
- m. China has again found **COVID on frozen beef**, various countries.
- n. Professor Ugur Sahin, chief executive of BioNTech predicted, **impact of the vaccine** will appear by next summer, with normality expected by the winter.
- o. Italy has reported **546 COVID-related deaths**.
- p. UN food agency cautioned 2021 will be **worse than 2020**.
- q. UK’s Scientific Advisory Group for Emergencies, said that there was a “worry” that **mutations of COVID-19** could mean vaccines “won’t work quite so well as hope.

2. National

- a. Pakistan has recorded **811 more recoveries from coronavirus**, taking the country's total recoveries to 323,225.

- b. Punjab Education minister has said that **Focus should be on smart lockdown** instead of complete shutdown of schools.
- c. KP has reported **most COVID-19 cases in a single day** in more than four months.
- d. Sindh reports over 900 cases second time in four days.
- e. Punjab reported **most COVID infections** in more than four months as cases continue to rise.
