




Cases Vs Recovery



Clinical Status of COVID





Death Analysis

1. International

- a. UK Health minister has said that many thousands of people in Britain are suffering from “**long COVID**”, **ongoing illness** after contracting COVID.
- b. Kenya doctors accuse govt of **not protecting healthcare workers** treating COVID-19 patients
- c. Sweden **limits public gatherings to 8 people** to fight pandemic.
- d. Scientists in UK have said that British PM Boris Johnson's “**Operation Moonshot**” for mass COVID-19 testing is likely to be ineffective and expensive
- e. Iran registers another **record daily increase** in coronavirus cases, fatalities.
- f. Johnson & Johnson has launched a new large-scale late-stage trial to test a two-dose regimen of its **experimental Covid-19 vaccine**.
- g. India has registered 30,548 new confirmed coronaviruses cases in the past 24 hours **lowest daily cases in 4 months**.
- h. Number of COVID cases in the US crossed **11-million mark**.
- i. Israel PM, has revealed that he has begun talks with Russia about buying the **country's Sputnik V vaccine for COVID-19**.
- j. WHO has said there is **no time for complacency in confronting the coronavirus**, despite positive news about possible vaccines.
- k. Italy has registered **27,354 new coronavirus infections** over the past 24 hours
- l. European commission wants to reach a deal with Moderna for the **supply of of its COVID-19 vaccine** for a price below \$25 per dose.
- m. Moderna Inc said that its experimental vaccine was **94.5% effective** in preventing COVID-19 based on interim data from a late-stage clinical trial.
- n. WHO head has said that vaccine will not by itself **halt the COVID pandemic**.
- o. Russia has recorded its **greatest daily increase in caseload**; confirming 22,778 new infections.
- p. Algeria has **imposed new COVID restrictions**, closing sport and cultural centres
- q. Six thousand British volunteers will be infected with an experimental COVID-19 vaccine which is modelled on the **Ebola jab** manufactured by Global Pharmaceutical company Janssen.

2. National

- a. Senate Secretariat has issued a notification announcing that in light of the current COVID-19 situation in the country, **meetings of all Senate committees will remain postponed** until further orders.

- b. PM Imran Khan has said that in light of increasing COVID cases, government has decided to **suspend public meetings and rallies across the country**.
- c. PPP member of Sindh Assembly **Sharjeel Inam Memon** has tested positive for the coronavirus
- d. **Sindh Chief Minister Murad Ali Shah** has tested positive for the coronavirus
- e. PM Imran Khan has urged **people to strictly follow SOPs** to curb coronavirus second wave.
