
Province-Wise COVID Cases





Death Analysis

International

- a. **European commission** has **recommended use of rapid COVID-19 antigen tests** on people already showing symptoms because it said that antigen kits were less accurate in detecting COVID in asymptomatic cases.
- b. US authorities have said that J&J vaccine will be **supplied commercially after domestic needs are met.**
- c. Spain has authorised the launch of **late-stage trials of J&J COVID-19 vaccine** candidate, which will also be tested in eight other nations.
- d. WHO data has revealed that number of new **COVID-19 cases in Europe declined** last week for the first time in over three months, but deaths continue to increase.
- e. Hungary has extended state of emergency until February, that **allows partial lockdown measures** to curb increase in COVID deaths.
- f. Iran has registers **13,421 new COVID cases**, taking total past 800,000.
- g. UN FAO, has said there is no significant evidence of **COVID being spread through food trade.**
- h. US has issued an **emergency use authorisation for the first self-administered rapid coronavirus test** that delivers results in 30 minutes.
- i. India has recorded **38,617 new COVID infections**, taking its tally to 8.9 million.
- j. Turkey has said new COVID measures will **limit the working hours of restaurants and cafes** and introducing a partial lockdown on weekends and will take effect from the evening of 20 Nov.
- k. Governments and officials across the world are voicing hopes that COVID-19 vaccines could bring "**herd immunity**", **with some calculating that immunising just two-thirds of a population could halt the pandemic** disease and help protect whole communities or nations.
- l. Greece plans to **set up more than 1,000 vaccination centres** as it awaits a successful vaccine against COVID-19.
- m. **Britain's** medicines regulator has said that it would **need to see the full data before making an assessment of Pfizer and BioNTech's** COVID-19 vaccine.
- n. WHO has launched **augmented reality "PPE buddy"** to help health workers with protective equipment.
- o. **Portugal** has set up a **taskforce to come up with vaccination strategy** and hopes to start distributing shots as early as January.

- p. **Pfizer Inc** has updated its analysis pertaining to safety profile of its COVID-19 vaccine, saying that **3.8% participants experienced fatigue** after receiving a second dose.
- q. Doctors in **Switzerland** say ICU beds are at full capacity as the **country continues to resist a second lockdown**.
- r. **Pfizer** had reported that its **COVID vaccine has an efficacy of 95%** and that it has passed its safety checks, according to new data from the firm.
- s. People in Germany have protested against Angela Merkel's plans to give her government **more powers to enforce restrictions to curb the spread of COVID-19**.
- t. **Ukraine** has registered a **record 256 new COVID-19-related deaths** in the past 24 hours.
- u. **South Australia**, has **reported COVID cases linked to hotel quarantine** in the past few days after reporting zero locally transmitted cases for 7 months, and has order 4000 people to isolate.
- v. **South Korea** reported **313 new daily COVID-19 cases**, highest since August.

2. **National**

- a. Punjab health department has **imposed smart lockdowns** in different areas of Multan, Lahore, Rawalpindi, Bhakkar, Bahawalpur and Sargodha that were identified as "hotspots" of the virus.
- b. **UAE has temporarily suspended the issuance of new visit visas** to Pakistan and 11 other countries.
