


Cases Vs Recovery




Clinical Status of COVID









Heat Map

1. International

- a. US government scientist Anthony Fauci has cautioned that **Americans should brace for a “surge upon a surge” of COVID** as millions of travellers return home after the Thanksgiving holiday.
- b. France's State Council (country's highest court) has ordered the government loosen coronavirus rules law **limiting the number of people in churches** during religious services to 30.
- c. World Health Organisation has delivered **15 ventilators to Gaza hospitals** amid a spike in Covid-19 infections.
- d. Hong Kong reported 115 new coronavirus infections highest in nearly four months.
- e. UK secures 2 million more doses of Moderna's Covid-19 vaccine.
- f. India's vaccine maker Serum Institute of India (SII) said it will **apply within two weeks for the emergency use of its COVID-19 vaccine**.
- g. Lebanon will begin to **slowly relaxing coronavirus restrictions imposed two weeks ago from Monday**, to boost its economy ahead of Christmas (restaurants will reopen at 50% capacity but bars and nightclubs will remain closed and weddings will be banned).
- h. Turkey's daily coronavirus death toll hit a record high for a seventh consecutive day with **185 fatalities in the last 24 hours**.
- i. New York mayor has said that state schools will start to **reopen on 7 December, beginning with primary schools** (schools were closed less than two weeks ago when positivity rates across the city passed 3% agreed by the mayor and teachers' union, in order to return students must have signed consent form agreeing to weekly COVID testing or a letter of medical exemption).
- j. Universities in the UK fined students more than £170,000 **for breaching coronavirus safety rules** in the first weeks of the new academic year.
- k. UK's Secretary of State for Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Affairs has said that **England is at risk of a third wave of COVID** in the new year if the right balance is not struck on restrictions.
- l. Czech Republic health minister has said that the **government will allow restaurants and non-essential shops to reopen** on Thursday as the current wave of the coronavirus pandemic eases.
- m. Russia has reported **26,683 new coronavirus cases in the last 24 hours**.

- n. Indonesia has reported a record rise in coronavirus infections, with **6,267 new cases and 169 deaths.**
- o. Australian state of Victoria, which has recorded 30 days with no confirmed coronavirus cases, has **eased some of its restrictions.**

2. **National**

- a. As per PMC official, any student who had tested positive for virus between November 15-29 will be **permitted to sit the special MDCAT exam to be held on 13 December.**
- b. Seventh member of the Pakistan cricket team in New Zealand has **tested positive for COVID-19.**
