




Cases Vs Recovery




Clinical Status of COVID




Death Analysis



Deaths





Heat Map

1. International

- a. **Global COVID-19 tally has crossed 35.3 million** while the pandemic has claimed more than one million lives so far.
- b. **WHO has said that roughly one in 10 people may have been infected with the coronavirus**, leaving the vast majority of the world's population vulnerable to the COVID-19 disease.
- c. New Zealand PM has said that New Zealand has **beat the virus again and announced restrictions in the country's largest city would be eased**, after a second COVID wave was contained.
- d. **Tunisian authorities have planned to ban all gatherings and reduce working hours for employees in the public sector** in order to stop the rapid spread of the coronavirus.
- e. **Iran's Health Ministry has said that nearly whole country was on a COVID red alert as cases and deaths rose to record levels**, with a member of the state task force's warning that field hospitals might be needed if people flout the rules.
- f. French health authorities have reported that **number of patients being treated in intensive care units (ICUs) for COVID-19 has gone beyond the 1,400**.
- g. Spain has become the **first Western European nation to surpass 800,000 total coronavirus cases after registering 23,480 new infections over the weekend**.
- h. New York governor has ordered **schools' closure in coronavirus hot spots**.
- i. **White House press secretary Kayleigh McEnany** has announced that she has tested positive for COVID-19.
- j. **India's coronavirus case tally has risen by 74,442 in the last 24 hours** to 6.63 million.

2. National

- a. **Federal minister Asad Umar urged the public to comply with the coronavirus SOPs** to ensure that the COVID-19 cases do not spike during the winter season.
- b. Prime Minister's Office has said that International Policy Centre for Inclusive Growth (IPC-IG) has acknowledged **Pakistan as one of the top-ranked countries in Asia with the highest number of responses to social protection**.
- c. **The Khyber Medical College in Peshawar has been closed for two weeks** due to the surge of COVID-19 cases.
