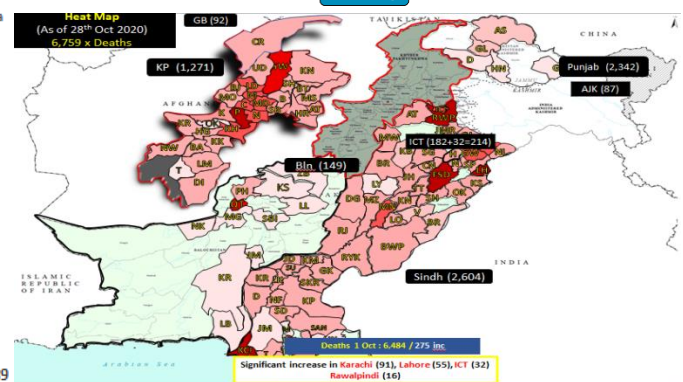
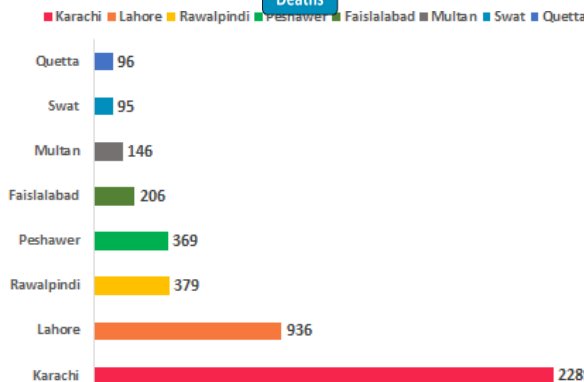
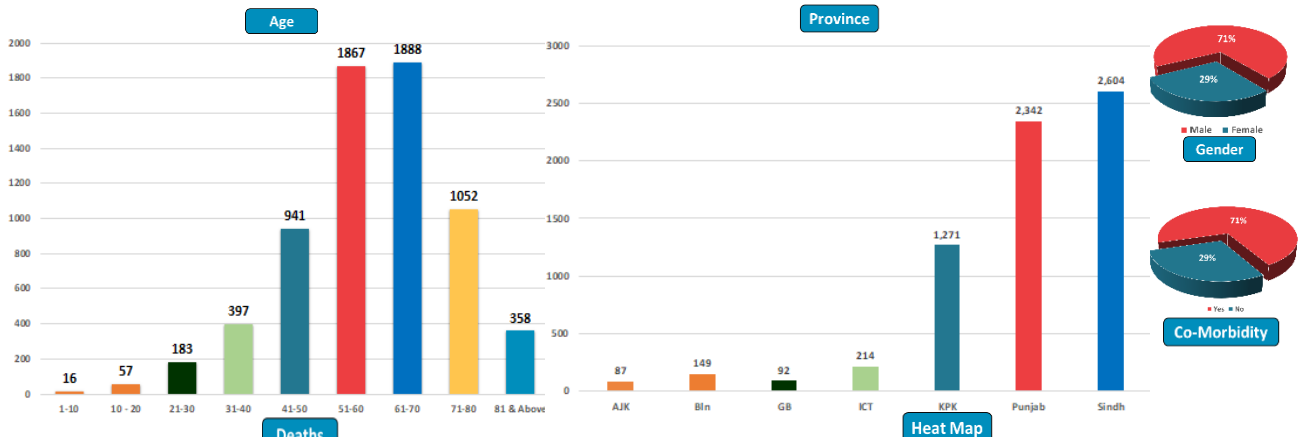
## Cases Vs Recovery



### Clinical Status of COVID

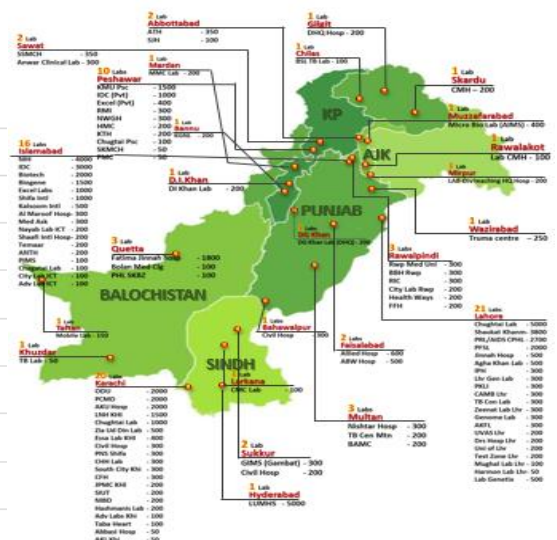
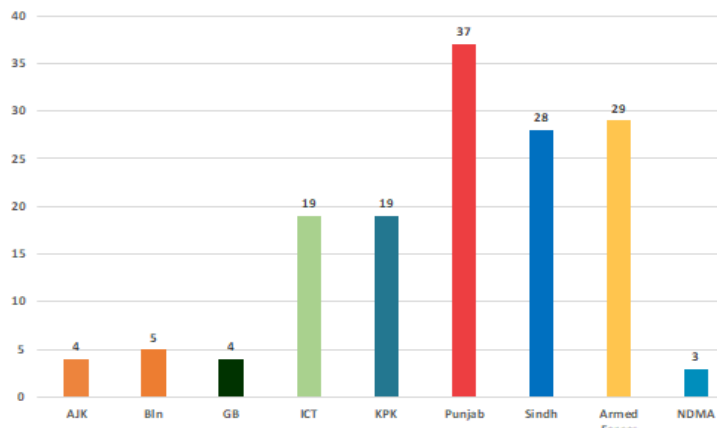

## 1. International

- a. Report published by Reuters has indicated that in the last week **nearly half a Mn people in US have contracted COVID**, while 5,600 people have died with hospitalizations increasing by 13 %.
- b. Belgium becomes **EU nation with highest rate of COVID-19 infections**.
- c. **Greece exceeds 1,200 daily COVID-19 infections** for first time.
- d. India has reported 36,470 newly confirmed coronavirus infections, **lowest one-day tally in more than three months**.
- e. Researchers have cautioned that People recovering from COVID-19 may **suffer significant brain function impacts**, with the worst cases of the infection linked to mental decline equivalent to the brain ageing by 10 years.
- f. EU has cautioned that **sufficient COVID vaccines for Europe will not be available until 2022**.
- g. **UN has cancelled all in-person meetings** at its New York headquarters after five people in Niger's UN mission were infected with the coronavirus.
- h. World Tourism Organization (WTO) has said that **International tourists' arrivals plunged by 70 %** during the first eight months of 2020 due to COVID.
- i. United Nations Secretary-General (UNSG) Antonio Guterres has called for **worldwide solidarity** to deal with the pandemic.

## 2. National

- a. SAPM on Health said that due to growing number of cases and deaths in the country, the **imposition of more restrictions was becoming "unavoidable"**.
- b. Pakistan is currently experiencing **start of second wave of COVID-19 pandemic**, Special Assistant to Prime Minister on Health Dr Faisal Sultan.
- c. Quaid-e-Azam University (QAU) in Islamabad was **temporarily closed on Monday after the emergence of five COVID-19 infections** in different departments.
